




WHEREAS, the Lawrence County legislative body deems that the public safety requires a lower speed limit within the confines of said subdivision and that such speed limit should be 35 mph.



INDUSTRIAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM (TIIP)

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Legislature has appropriated Fifty Million (\$50,000,000.00) Dollars in State funds to the Tennessee department of Economic and Community Development to be used by local governments for infra structure improvements required to facilitate the creation and retention of jobs within their communities; and
