

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE, SALE, AND PAYMENT OF INTEREST-BEARING LAWRENCE COUNTY EDUCATION CAPITAL PROJECT FUND TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES NOT TO EXCEED \$180,000.00

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, (the "local Government") has determined that it is necessary and desirable to borrow a limited amount of funds to meet appropriations made for the Lawrence County Education Capital Project Fund (the "Fund") for the current fiscal year, being July 1, 1993 through June 30, 1994, inclusive, (the "Fiscal Year"), in anticipation of the collection of taxes and revenues for the Fund during the Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Parts I, IV and VIII of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Act") local governments in Tennessee are authorized to issue and sell interest-bearing tax anticipation notes in amounts not exceeding sixty percent (60%) of the Fund appropriation for the Fiscal Year upon the approval of the State Director of Local Finance; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that it is advantageous to the Local Government to authorize the issuance and sale of tax anticipation notes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. That, for the purpose of providing funds to meet certain appropriations for the Fiscal Year, the Lawrence County Education Capital Project Fund of the Local Government is hereby authorized in accordance with the terms of this Resolution to issue and sell interest-bearing tax anticipation notes in a principal amount not to exceed One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000.00) (the "Notes") at

either a competitive public sale or at a private negotiated sale upon approval of the State Director of Local Finance pursuant to the terms, provisions, and conditions permitted by law. The Notes shall be designated "Lawrence County Education Capital Project Fund Tax Anticipation Notes, Series 1993"; shall be numbered serially from 1 upwards; shall be dated as of the date of issuance; shall be in denomination(s) as agreed upon with the purchaser; shall be sold at not less than par value and accrued interest; and shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum, and in no event shall the rate exceed the legal limit provided by law.

Section 2. That, the sum of the principal amount of the Notes, together with the principal amount or amounts of any prior tax anticipation notes issued during the Fiscal Year, does not exceed sixty percent (60%) of the Fund appropriation for the Fiscal Year.

Section 3. That, the Notes may be renewed from time to time and money may be borrowed from time to time for the payment of any indebtedness evidenced by the Notes; provided, that the Notes and any renewal notes shall mature and be paid in full without renewal on or before the end of the Fiscal Year. If the Local Government overestimates the amount of taxes and revenue collected for the Fiscal Year and it becomes impossible to retire the Notes and all renewal notes prior to the close of the Fiscal Year, then the Local Government shall apply to the State Director of Local Finance within ten (10) days prior to the close of the Fiscal Year for permission to issue funding bonds to cover the unpaid Notes in the manner provided by Title 9, Chapter 11 of Tennessee Code Annotated or as otherwise provided for in a manner approved by the State Director of Local Finance.

Section 4. That, the Notes shall be secured solely by the receipt of taxes and revenues by the Fund during the Fiscal Year.

Section 5. That, the Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the Local government, in whole or in part, at any time, at the principal amount and accrued interest to the date of redemption without a premium.


Section 6. That, the Notes shall be executed in the name of the Local Government and bear the manual signature of the chief executive officer of the Local Government and the manual signature of the County Clerk with the Local Government seal affixed thereon; and shall be payable as to principal and interest at the office of the County Trustee of the Local Government or the paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government. Proceeds of the Notes shall be deposited with the Lawrence County Education Capital Project Fund of the Local Government and shall be paid out for the purpose of meeting Fund appropriations made for the Fiscal Year in anticipation of the collection of revenues and taxes pursuant to this Resolution and as required by law.

Section 7. That, the Notes shall be in substantially the form attached hereto and shall recite that the notes are issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated.

Section 8. That, the Notes shall be sold only after the receipt of the approval of the State Director of Local Finance for the sale of the Notes.

Section 9. That, all orders or resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

LAWRENCE COUNTY (the "County"), lawfully and existing under the laws of the State of Tennessee, for value received, hereby acknowledges itself indebted and promises to pay, as hereinafter set forth, in the manner hereinafter provided, to the Registered Owner identified above, or registered assigns as hereinafter provided, on the Maturity Date identified above, or earlier as hereinafter provided, upon the presentation and surrender hereof at the office of the County Trustee, Lawrence County, Tennessee, or its successor as registrar and paying agent (the "Note Registrar"), the Principal Amount identified above and to pay interest on said Principal Amount from the date hereof, or such later date to which interest has been paid, in six (6) equal monthly payments of \$30,000.00, commencing on January 1, 1994, at the Interest Rate per annum set forth above, until payment of said Principal Amount, by check, draft, or warrant to the registered holder hereof at the address shown on the registration books of the Note Registrar on the fifteenth calendar day next preceding an Interest Payment Date, in any coin or currency of the United States of America which on the date of payment thereof is legal tender for the payment of public and private debts.



ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This note is one of a series of notes known as "Lawrence County Education Capital Project Fund Tax Anticipation Note, Series 1993" (the "Note"), issued by the County in the aggregate principal amount of One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000.00), consisting of Notes maturing serially on June 1, in the year 1994. The Notes which are issued for the purpose of financing the expenses of the Board of Education, are authorized by an appropriate resolution of the Lawrence County Board of Education and particularly that certain Resolution of the Lawrence County Board of Education adopted on September 20, 1993, entitled "Resolution of the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, Authorizing the Issuance, Sale, and Payment of Interest-Bearing Lawrence County Education Capital Project Fund Tax Anticipation Notes not to Exceed \$180,000.00", as such Resolution may be from time to time amended or supplemented in accordance with its terms (such Resolution as so amended or supplemented, being herein called, the "Note Resolution"), and are issued pursuant to, and in full compliance with, the Constitution and the statutes of the State of Tennessee, including, but not limited to, Title 9, Chapter 21, Parts 1, 4, and 6, Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended (the "Act"). Copies of said resolutions, including the Note Resolution, are on file at the office of the County Clerk of the County, and reference is hereby made to said resolutions, including the Note Resolution and the Act, for a more complete statement of the terms and conditions upon which the Notes are issued thereunder, the rights, duties, immunities, and obligations of the County, and the rights of the Registered Owner hereof.

This note is a direct general obligation of the County payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied on all taxable property in the County without limitation as to time, rate, or amount. For the prompt payment of this note, both principal and interest, as the same shall become due, the full faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

The County has designated the Notes as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

This note is transferable by the registered owner hereof in person or by his, her, or its attorney or legal representative at the office of the Note Registrar, but only in the manner and subject to the limitations and conditions provided in the Note Resolution and upon surrender and cancellation of this note. Upon any such transfer, the County shall execute and the Note Registrar shall authenticate and deliver in exchange for this note a new fully registered note or notes, registered in the name of the transferee, in authorized denominations, in an aggregate principal amount equal to the principal amount of this note, of the same maturity and bearing interest at the same rate. For every exchange or transfer of notes, whether temporary or definitive, the County and the Note Registrar may make a charge, unless otherwise herein to the contrary

expressly provided, sufficient to pay for any tax, fee, or other governmental charge required to be paid with respect to such exchange or transfer, all of which taxes, fees, or other governmental charges shall be paid to the County by the person or entity requesting such exchange or transfer as a condition precedent to the exercise of the privilege of making such exchange or transfer.

The County and the Note Registrar may deem and treat the person or entity in whose name this note is registered as the absolute owner hereof, whether such note shall be overdue or not, for the purpose of making payment of the principal of and interest on, this note and for all other purposes. All such payments so made shall be valid and effectual to satisfy and discharge the liability upon this note to the extent of the sum or sums so paid, and neither the County nor the Note Registrar shall be affected by any notice to the contrary.

The Notes are issuable only as fully registered Notes, without coupons. At the office of the Note Registrar, in the manner and subject to the limitations, conditions, and charges provided in the Note Resolution, fully registered Notes may be exchanged for an equal aggregate principal amount of fully registered Notes of the same maturity, of authorized denominations, and bearing interest at the same rate.

The Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the County prior to maturity in whole or in part, without premium, at the principal amount thereof plus accrued interest to the date of redemption.

This note shall have all the qualities and incidents of, and shall be a negotiable instrument under the Uniform Commercial Code of the State of Tennessee, subject only to provisions respecting registration of such note. This note is issued with the intent that the laws of the State of Tennessee shall govern its construction.

It is hereby certified, recited, and declared that all acts and conditions required to be done and to exist precedent to the issuance of, this note in order to make this note a legal, valid, and binding obligation of the County, have been done, and did exist in due time and form as required by the Constitution and statutes of the State of Tennessee; and that this note and the issue of which it is a part, together with all other indebtedness of such County, does not exceed any limitation prescribed by the Constitution or statutes of the State of Tennessee.

CONTRACT
BETWEEN

THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND
LAWRENCE COUNTY

THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into by and between the State of Tennessee, acting through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as the "Department", and Lawrence County, hereinafter referred to as the "County".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 41-2-123, the Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties for the purpose of funding programs for the collection of litter and trash along county, state and interstate roads and highways; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 57-5-201 and 67-4-402, proportions of the privilege taxes imposed by said sections are allocated to the highway fund for the purpose of funding programs for the prevention and collection of litter and trash and matters related thereto; and

WHEREAS, the County has submitted an application to the Department for the purpose of obtaining program funds for the prevention of the accumulation of litter and depositing of trash

and the collection of litter and trash along county, state, interstate roads and highways as described in said application, and

WHEREAS, said application has been approved by the Commissioner, and the parties want to enter into an agreement to provide the terms and conditions to govern the expenditure of program funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the parties agree that their respective obligations for administering the program for the prevention of the accumulation of litter and depositing of trash along county, state and interstate roads and highways and the collection of litter and trash from said roads and highways shall be as follows:

1. The County agrees that it will undertake its program for the prevention of the accumulation of litter and depositing of trash, and collection of litter and trash as contained in its application, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", and in accordance with its budget, attached hereto as "Exhibit B", which exhibits are hereby incorporated herein by reference.
2. The County agrees not to employ any elected official in carrying out the program.
3. The County agrees that not more than ten percent (10%) of the funds provided for herein shall be expended for the purpose of advertising or promoting the program, and no part of such funds shall be used to purchase supplies, materials, or equipment displaying the name or likeness of the administrator of

the program, or of any other individual.

4. It is understood by the County that if accomplishment of the program includes use of labor by prisoners, it will use those sentenced to the county workhouse. The County may require such labor pursuant to the provisions of T.C.A., Section 41-2-149.

5. It is understood by the County that the maximum amount of compensation subject to being paid to the County as reimbursement shall not exceed the sum of \$36,127.00.

6. The term of this Contract shall be from date of execution to June 30, 1994.

7. The County agrees to provide monthly invoices reflecting actual costs incurred subject to the cost limitation set forth in Provision No. 5. The monthly invoice shall set forth in detail the amount expended pursuant to the budget, be supported by receipted bills and payroll time sheets, contain a notarized statement relating to accuracy, be accompanied by a progress report describing accomplishments and problems encountered during the month and work anticipated during the subsequent month, and be submitted in triplicate to the Department's Highway Beautification Office, Suite 400, James K. Polk Building, Nashville, TN 37243-0333, within ten (10) days following the end of each month.

8. The Department agrees to honor all invoices for reimbursement of costs provided the County is complying with its obligations provided for in "Exhibit A". The Department will pay actual operating costs for any vehicles and other mobile equipment used in accomplishing program work, but not to exceed

the amounts set forth in the Rental Rate Blue Book for Construction Equipment.

9. The County agrees to comply with applicable requirements of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

10. The County agrees to require persons working on or adjacent to the highway right-of-way to wear safety colored vests.

11. The County agrees to use competitive bidding procedures in the procurement of goods, materials, supplies, equipment or services.

12. The County agrees to be responsible for the accountability, management, and inventory of all property acquired in whole or in part with funds provided hereunder.

13. The performance and effectiveness of the County in accomplishing the work shall be subject to quarterly review by Department officials.

14. If the County fails to fulfill in a timely and proper manner its obligations under this Contract, or if the County shall violate any of its terms, the Department shall have the right to immediately terminate this Contract and shall have not further obligation for payment in excess of fair reimbursement as compensation for work completed.

15. This Contract may be modified only by written amendment executed by all parties hereto.

16. No person on the ground of handicap, race, color, religion, sex or natural origin, will be excluded from

participation in, or be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the performance of this Contract, or in the employment practices of the County. The County agrees, upon request, to show proof of such nondiscrimination, and to post in conspicuous places, available to all employees and applicants, notices of nondiscrimination.

17. This Contract may be terminated by either party, without cause being assigned, by giving written notice to the other at least thirty (30) days before the effective date of termination. In that event the County shall be entitled to receive fair reimbursement as compensation for any satisfactory authorized work completed as of the termination date.

18. The County agrees to maintain documentation for all charges against the Department under this Contract. The books, records and documents of the County related to work performed or money received under this Contract, shall be maintained for a period of three (3) full years from the date of the final payment, and shall be subject to audit, at any reasonable time and upon reasonable notice by the Department, the Comptroller of the Treasury, or their duly appointed representatives. The records shall be maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and at no less than those recommended in the accounting Manual for Recipients of Grant Funds in Tennessee, published by the Comptroller of the Treasury, State of Tennessee.

19. This Contract is in implementation of T.C.A., Section 41-2-123(c) to fund the County's program for the collection of litter and trash along county, state and interstate roads and

highways and for no other purpose. The County understands that it shall have full control of and liability for all work activities provided for as an independent contractor and not as an agent of the Department

20. The County agrees not to assign or sublet any interest in this Contract.

HOUSE BILL NO. 1664

AN ACT relative to the regulation and licensure of automobile race tracks and drag strips in counties having a population of not less than thirty-five thousand three hundred (35,300) nor more than thirty-five thousand five hundred (35,500) according to the 1990 Federal Census or any subsequent Federal Census, and to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 22.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-22-101, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

() (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter to the contrary, upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the county legislative body in any county having a population of not less than thirty-five thousand three hundred (35,300) nor more than thirty-five thousand five hundred (35,500) according to the 1990 Federal Census or any subsequent Federal Census, the county legislative body shall have the authority to regulate and license permanent automobile race tracks or other places for the holding of such races upon which motor vehicles of any description are raced in such county.

(2) In the resolution or ordinance adopting such county's regulation and licensure of automobile race tracks located in such county, the county legislative body shall provide for and set the application fees for licenses to operate or conduct a race track; provide for the disposition of such fees; establish the conditions for granting such licenses; establish minimum liability insurance coverage to be maintained by the licensee; provide for the expiration dates and renewal procedures for such licenses; enumerate causes for the revocation of such licenses and procedures for the reinstatement thereof; establish penalties for the conduct or operation of a race track without a license; provide for the times, dates and conditions under which licensees may conduct races; and establish any other rule or regulation relative to the regulation and licensure of automobile race tracks that such county legislative body deems prudent and advisable.

(3) The provisions of this act shall not apply to any permanent automobile race track or other place for the holding of such races that has been in operation for at least two (2) years prior to the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE, SALE, AND PAYMENT OF INTEREST-BEARING LAWRENCE COUNTY HIGHWAY CAPITAL PROJECT FUND TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.00

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, (the "local Government") has determined that it is necessary and desirable to borrow a limited amount of funds to meet appropriations made for the Lawrence County Highway Capital Project Fund (the "Fund") for the current fiscal year, being July 1, 1993 through June 30, 1994, inclusive, (the "Fiscal Year"), in anticipation of the collection of taxes and revenues for the Fund during the Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Parts I, IV and VIII of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Act") local governments in Tennessee are authorized to issue and sell interest-bearing tax anticipation notes in amounts not exceeding sixty percent (60%) of the Fund appropriation for the Fiscal Year upon the approval of the State Director of Local Finance; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that it is advantageous to the Local Government to authorize the issuance and sale of tax anticipation notes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. That, for the purpose of providing funds to meet certain appropriations for the Fiscal Year, the Lawrence County Highway Capital Project Fund of the Local Government is hereby authorized in accordance with the terms of this Resolution to issue and sell interest-bearing tax anticipation notes in a principal amount not to exceed Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) (the "Notes") at either a competitive

public sale or at a private negotiated sale upon approval of the State Director of Local Finance pursuant to the terms, provisions, and conditions permitted by law. The Notes shall be designated "Lawrence County Highway Capital Project Fund Tax Anticipation Notes, Series 1993"; shall be numbered serially from 1 upwards; shall be dated as of the date of issuance; shall be in denomination(s) as agreed upon with the purchaser; shall be sold at not less than par value and accrued interest; and shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum, and in no event shall the rate exceed the legal limit provided by law.

Section 2. That, the sum of the principal amount of the Notes, together with the principal amount or amounts of any prior tax anticipation notes issued during the Fiscal Year, does not exceed sixty percent (60%) of the Fund appropriation for the Fiscal Year.

Section 3. That, the Notes may be renewed from time to time and money may be borrowed from time to time for the payment of any indebtedness evidenced by the Notes; provided, that the Notes and any renewal notes shall mature and be paid in full without renewal on or before the end of the Fiscal Year. If the Local Government overestimates the amount of taxes and revenue collected for the Fiscal Year and it becomes impossible to retire the Notes and all renewal notes prior to the close of the Fiscal Year, then the Local Government shall apply to the State Director of Local Finance within ten (10) days prior to the close of the Fiscal Year for permission to issue funding bonds to cover the unpaid Notes in the manner provided by Title 9, Chapter 11 of Tennessee Code Annotated or as otherwise provided for in a manner approved by the State Director of Local Finance.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS


This note is one of a series of notes known as "Lawrence County Highway Capital Project Fund Tax Anticipation Note, Series 1993" (the "Note"), issued by the County in the aggregate principal amount of One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000.00), consisting of Notes maturing serially on June 1, in the year 1994. The Notes which are issued for the purpose of financing the expenses of the Highway Department, are authorized by an appropriate resolution of the Lawrence County Highway Department and particularly that certain Resolution of the Lawrence County Highway Department adopted on September 20, 1993, entitled "Resolution of the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, Authorizing the Issuance, Sale, and Payment of Interest-Bearing Lawrence County Highway Capital Project Fund Tax Anticipation Notes not to Exceed \$ 60,000.00 ", as such Resolution may be from time to time amended or supplemented in accordance with its terms (such Resolution as so amended or supplemented, being herein called, the "Note Resolution"), and are issued pursuant to, and in full compliance with, the Constitution and the statutes of the State of Tennessee, including, but not limited to, Title 9, Chapter 21, Parts 1, 4, and 6, Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended (the "Act"). Copies of said resolutions, including the Note Resolution, are on file at the office of the County Clerk of the County, and reference is hereby made to said resolutions, including the Note Resolution and the Act, for a more complete statement of the terms and conditions upon which the Notes are issued thereunder, the rights, duties, immunities, and obligations of the County, and the rights of the Registered Owner hereof.

This note is a direct general obligation of the County payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied on all taxable property in the County without limitation as to time, rate, or amount. For the prompt payment of this note, both principal and interest, as the same shall become due, the full faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

The County has designated the Notes as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

This note is transferable by the registered owner hereof in person or by his, her, or its attorney or legal representative at the office of the Note Registrar, but only in the manner and subject to the limitations and conditions provided in the Note Resolution and upon surrender and cancellation of this note. Upon any such transfer, the County shall execute and the Note Registrar shall authenticate and deliver in exchange for this note a new fully registered note or notes, registered in the name of the transferee, in authorized denominations, in an aggregate principal amount equal to the principal amount of this note, of the same maturity and bearing interest at the same rate. For every exchange or transfer of notes, whether temporary or definitive, the County and the Note Registrar may make a charge, unless otherwise herein to the contrary

Section 4. That, the Notes shall be secured solely by the receipt of taxes and revenues by the Fund during the Fiscal Year.

Section 5. That, the Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the Local government, in whole or in part, at any time, at the principal amount and accrued interest to the date of redemption without a premium.

Section 6. That, the Notes shall be executed in the name of the Local Government and bear the manual signature of the chief executive officer of the Local Government and the manual signature of the County Clerk with the Local Government seal affixed thereon; and shall be payable as to principal and interest at the office of the County Trustee of the Local Government or the paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government. Proceeds of the Notes shall be deposited with the Lawrence County Highway Capital Project Fund of the Local Government and shall be paid out for the purpose of meeting Fund appropriations made for the Fiscal Year in anticipation of the collection of revenues and taxes pursuant to this Resolution and as required by law.

Section 7. That, the Notes shall be in substantially the form attached hereto and shall recite that the notes are issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated.

Section 8. That, the Notes shall be sold only after the receipt of the approval of the State Director of Local Finance for the sale of the Notes.


