

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 41-2-123, the Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties for the purpose of funding programs for the collection of litter and trash along county, state and interstate roads and highways; and

WHEREAS, the County has submitted an application to the Department for the purpose of obtaining program funds for the prevention of the accumulation of litter and depositing of trash and the collection of litter and trash along county, state, interstate roads and highways as described in said application, and

WHEREAS, the application has been approved by the Commissioner, and the parties want to enter into an agreement to provide the terms and conditions to govern the expenditure of program funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lawrence County Board of Commissioners meeting in regular session on the 26th day of September, 1994 approve the attached contract No. CHB336, Project No. 50-500-4062-04 between The State of Tennessee, Department of Transportation and Lawrence County to provide for the collection and disposal of litter along county, state and interstate roads and highways.

CONTRACT
BETWEEN
THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND
LAWRENCE COUNTY

THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into by and between the State of Tennessee, acting through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as the "Department", and Lawrence County, hereinafter referred to as the "County".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 41-2-123, the Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties for the purpose of funding programs for the collection of litter and trash along county, state and interstate roads and highways; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 57-5-201 and 67-4-402, proportions of the privilege taxes imposed by said sections are allocated to the highway fund for the purpose of funding programs for the prevention and collection of litter and trash and matters related thereto; and

WHEREAS, the County has submitted an application to the Department for the purpose of obtaining program funds for the prevention of the accumulation of litter and depositing of trash

and the collection of litter and trash along county, state, interstate roads and highways as described in said application,

and

WHEREAS, said application has been approved by the Commissioner, and the parties want to enter into an agreement to provide the terms and conditions to govern the expenditure of program funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the parties agree that their respective obligations for administering the program for the prevention of the accumulation of litter and depositing of trash along county, state and interstate roads and highways and the collection of litter and trash from said roads and highways shall be as follows:

1. The County agrees that it will undertake its program for the prevention of the accumulation of litter and depositing of trash, and collection of litter and trash in accordance with its budget, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", which exhibit is hereby incorporated herein by reference.
2. The County agrees not to employ any elected official in carrying out the program.
3. The County agrees that not more than ten percent (10%) of the funds provided for herein shall be expended for the purpose of advertising or promoting the program, no part of such funds shall be used to purchase supplies, materials, or equipment displaying the name or likeness of the administrator of the program, or of any other individual. The County further agrees

that it will spend \$7,200.00 for litter prevention education under 4 of the following categories: Student Education (S); Public Education (P); Governmental Education (G); Media Education (M); and Business Education (B).

4. It is understood by the County that if accomplishment of the program includes use of labor by prisoners, it will use those sentenced to the county workhouse. The County may require such labor pursuant to the provisions of T.C.A., Section 41-2-149.

5. It is understood by the County that the maximum amount of compensation subject to being paid to the County as reimbursement shall not exceed the sum of \$36,127.00.

6. The term of this Contract shall be from July 1, 1994 through June 30, 1995.

7. The County agrees to provide monthly invoices reflecting actual costs incurred subject to the cost limitation set forth in Provision No. 5. The monthly invoice shall set forth in detail the amount expended pursuant to the budget, be supported by receipted bills and payroll time sheets, contain a notarized statement relating to accuracy, be accompanied by a progress report describing accomplishments and problems encountered during the month and work anticipated during the subsequent month, and be submitted in triplicate. The invoice will be in accordance with the March 1994 County Uniform Chart of Accounts, including the utilization of Function Code 55720 if the program will be administered by the County Executive or Sheriff, or 64000 if administered by the County Highway Department. It is understood by the County that they will also use object codes contained in

said chart of accounts and letter codes contained in parenthesis following each litter prevention education category listed in section 3 of this contract. This monthly invoice shall be submitted to the Department's Highway Beautification Office, Suite 400, James K. Polk Building, Nashville, TN 37243-0333, within ten (10) days following the end of each month.

8. The Department agrees to honor all invoices for reimbursement of costs provided the County is complying with its obligations provided for in "Exhibit A". The Department will pay actual operating costs for any vehicles and other mobile equipment used in accomplishing program work, but not to exceed the amounts set forth in the Rental Rate Blue Book for Construction Equipment.

9. The County agrees to comply with applicable requirements of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

10. The County agrees to require persons working on or adjacent to the highway right-of-way to wear safety colored vests.

11. The County agrees to use competitive bidding procedures in the procurement of goods, materials, supplies, equipment or services.

12. The County agrees to be responsible for the accountability, management, and inventory of all property acquired in whole or in part with funds provided hereunder.

13. The performance and effectiveness of the County in accomplishing the work shall be subject to quarterly review by department officials.

14. If the County fails to fulfill in a timely and proper manner its obligations under this Contract, or if the County shall violate any of its terms, the Department shall have the right to immediately terminate this Contract and shall have not further obligation for payment in excess of fair reimbursement as compensation for work completed.

15. This Contract may be modified only by written amendment executed by all parties hereto.

16. No person on the ground of handicap, race, color, religion, sex or natural origin, will be excluded from participation in, or be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the performance of this Contract, or in the employment practices of the County. The County agrees, upon request, to show proof of such nondiscrimination, and to post in conspicuous places, available to all employees and applicants, notices of nondiscrimination.

17. This Contract may be terminated by either party, without cause being assigned, by giving written notice to the other at least thirty (30) days before the effective date of termination. In that event the County shall be entitled to receive fair reimbursement as compensation for any satisfactory authorized work completed as of the termination date.

18. The County agrees to maintain documentation for all charges against the Department under this Contract. The books,

records and documents of the County related to work performed or money received under this Contract, shall be maintained for a period of three (3) full years from the date of the final payment, and shall be subject to audit, at any reasonable time and upon reasonable notice by the Department, the Comptroller of the Treasury, or their duly appointed representatives. The records shall be maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and at no less than those recommended in the accounting Manual for Recipients of Grant Funds in Tennessee, published by the Comptroller of the Treasury, State of Tennessee.

19. This Contract is in implementation of T.C.A., Section 41-2-123(c) to fund the County's program for the collection of litter and trash along county, state and interstate roads and highways and for no other purpose. The County understands that it shall have full control of and liability for all work activities provided for as an independent contractor and not as an agent of the Department

20. The County agrees not to assign or sublet any interest in this Contract.

RESOLUTION OF LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN INTEREST BEARING GENERAL OBLIGATION CAPITAL OUTLAY NOTES, SERIES 1994, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$607,000.00, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAID NOTES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of Lawrence County, Tennessee (the "County"), has determined that it is necessary and desirable to authorize, issue, sell, and provide for the payment of its interest bearing capital outlay notes to finance certain public works projects, including, the purchase of computer software and hardware for the Lawrence County Board of Education and the purchase of motor vehicles for the Lawrence County Sheriff's Department (collectively, the "Project");

WHEREAS, the County finds and determines that the Project is essential to the health, welfare, and safety of the public;

WHEREAS, in order to proceed as expeditiously as possible with such an essential Project, it is necessary that an interest bearing capital outlay notes be issued for the purpose of providing funds to finance the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the County is authorized by the provisions of Title 9, Chapter 21, Parts 1, 4, and 6, Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended, to issue such notes for said purposes upon the approval of the State of Tennessee Director of Local Finance (the "Director of Local Finance");

WHEREAS, it appears advantageous to said County at this particular time to issue capital outlay notes to finance the cost thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authority. The Notes herein authorized shall be issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, parts 1, 4, and 6, Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended, and other applicable provisions of law.

Section 2. Authorization. For the purpose of providing funds to finance the costs of the Project, there shall be issued pursuant to, and in accordance with, the provisions of Title 9, Chapter 21, Parts 1, 4, and 6, Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended, and other applicable provisions of law, the interest bearing capital outlay notes of the

County, in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed Six Hundred Seven Thousand Dollars (\$607,000.00) (the "Notes"). The term of the Notes shall not exceed 3 years.

Section 3. Term of the Notes. The Notes shall be designated "General Obligation Capital Outlay Notes, Series 1994". The Notes shall be issued in registered form, without coupons. The Notes shall be numbered from 1 upwards, shall be dated as of the date of issuance, shall be in denominations as agreed upon with the purchaser, shall mature not later than three (3) years after issuance, provided, that not less than one-ninth (1/9) of the original principal amount of the notes issued hereunder shall mature, without renewal but subject to prior redemption, each year that any of the notes issued hereunder are outstanding, shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed 7.0% per annum, such interest being payable in such manner as shall be determined by the County Executive and the purchaser of said notes.

Interest on the Notes shall be payable by check or other form of draft of the Note Registrar, deposited by the Note Registrar in the United States mail, first class postage prepaid, in sealed envelopes, addressed to the Owners of such Notes, as of the applicable interest payment date, at their respective addresses as shown on the registration books of the County maintained by the Note Registrar as of the close of business fifteen (15) calendar days preceding the next interest payment date. The principal of all Notes shall be payable upon presentation and surrender of such Notes at the principal office of the Note Registrar. All payments of the principal of and interest on the Notes shall be made in any coin or currency of the United States of America which, on the date of payment thereof, shall be legal tender for the payment of public and private debts.

Section 4. Redemption. The Note shall be subject to redemption prior to maturity without premium at any time.

Section 5. Execution. The Note shall be executed in the name of the County; shall bear the manual or facsimile signature of the County Executive; shall be countersigned by the County Clerk with his or her manual or facsimile signature and shall have printed or impressed thereon the official seal of the County. In the event any officer whose signature appears on the Note shall cease to be such officer, such signature shall nevertheless be valid and sufficient for all purposes. The Note shall be issued in typed, mimeographed, printed or photocopied form, or any combination thereof, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which such minor changes therein or such variations thereof as the County Executive may deem necessary or desirable, the blanks to be appropriately completed by the County Executive prior to issuance.

Section 6. Registration, negotiability, and Payment. (a) The County Trustee of

the County is hereby appointed the note registrar and paying agent (the "Note Registrar"), and as such shall establish and maintain suitable books (the "Registration Books") for recording the registration, conversion, and payment of the Note, and shall also perform such other duties as may be required in connection with any of the foregoing. The Note Registrar is hereby authorized to authenticate and deliver the Note to the original purchaser thereof, or as he or she may designate, upon receipt by the County of the proceeds of the sale thereof and to authenticate and deliver the Note in exchange for a Note of the same principal amount delivered for transfer upon receipt of the Note to be transferred in proper form with proper documentation as hereinbefore described. The Note shall not be valid for any purpose unless authenticated by the Note Registrar by the manual signature of such Note Registrar. The Note shall be fully registered as to both principal and interest and shall be fully negotiable upon proper endorsement by the registered owner thereof. No transfer of the Note will be valid unless such transfer is noted upon the Registration Books and until such Note is surrendered, canceled, and exchanged for a new Note which shall be issued to the transferee, subject to all the conditions contained herein, having the same maturity, bearing interest at the same rate of interest, and in the same aggregate principal amount, all as the surrendered Note. principal and interest on the Note shall be paid at maturity upon presentation or surrender of the Note at the principal office of the Note Registrar, and payment in such manner shall forever discharge and release the obligation of the County to the extent of the principal and interest so paid.

(b) The County may from time to time at its discretion remove the Note Registrar and appoint a successor Note Registrar to whom all records, documents, and instruments relating to its duties as Note Registrar shall be delivered. Any successor Note Registrar shall be appointed by resolution of the County, and shall be a trust company or bank having the powers of a trust company, having, at the time of such appointment, a combined capital, surplus, and undivided profits aggregating at least Ten Million dollars (\$10,000,000.00), and be willing and able to accept the office of Note Registrar on reasonable and customary terms and authorized by law to perform all duties imposed upon it by this Resolution.

(c) In the event that any amount payable on any Note as interest shall at any time exceed the rate of interest lawfully chargeable thereon under applicable law, then any such excess shall, to the extent of such excess, be applied against the principal of such Note as a prepayment thereof without penalty, and such excess shall not be considered to be interest. All rates of interest specified herein shall be computed on the basis of a three hundred sixty (360) day year composed of twelve (12) months of thirty (30) days each.

Section 7. Exchange of the Note. The Note, upon surrender thereof at the office of the Note Registrar, together with an assignment of such Note duly executed by the registered owner thereof, or his, her, or its attorney or legal representative, may be exchanged for an equal aggregate principal amount of a Note of the same maturity, of

any denomination or denominations authorized by this Resolution, and bearing interest at the same rate as the Note surrendered for exchange.

Section 8. Transfer of Note. Each Note shall be transferable only on the registration books maintained by the Note Registrar at the principal office of the Note Registrar, upon the surrender for cancellation thereof at the principal office of the Note Registrar, together with an assignment of such Note duly executed by the registered owner thereof or his, her or its attorney or legal representative, and upon payment of the charges hereinafter provided, and subject to such other limitations and conditions as may be provided therein or herein. Upon the cancellation of any such Note, the Note Registrar shall, in exchange for the surrendered Note, deliver in the name of the transferee or transferees a new Note of authorized denominations, of the same aggregate principal amount, maturity, and rate of interest as such surrendered Note, and the transferee or transferees shall take such new Note subject to all of the conditions herein contained.

Section 9. Regulations with Respect to Exchanges and Transfers. In all cases in which the privilege of exchanging or transferring a Note is exercised, the County shall execute, and the Note Registrar shall deliver, a Note in accordance with the provisions of this Resolution. For every exchange or transfer of the Note, whether temporary or definitive, the County and the Note Registrar may make a charge, unless otherwise herein to the contrary expressly provided, sufficient to pay for any tax, fee, or other governmental charge required to be paid with respect to such exchange or transfer, all of which taxes, fees, and other governmental charges shall be paid to the County by the person or entity requesting such exchange or transfer as a condition precedent to the exercise of the privilege of making such exchange or transfer.

Neither the County nor the Note Registrar shall be obligated to exchange or transfer any Note after the fifteenth (15) calendar day next preceding an interest payment date.

Section 10. Mutilated, Lost, Stolen, or Destroyed Note. In the event any Note issued hereunder shall become mutilated, or be lost, stolen or destroyed, it shall, at the written request of the registered owner, be canceled on the Registration Books and a new Note shall be authenticated and delivered, corresponding in all aspect but number to the mutilated, lost, stolen, or destroyed Note. thereafter, should such mutilated, lost, stolen, or destroyed Note come into possession of the registered owner, such Note shall be returned to the Note Registrar for destruction by the Note Registrar. If the principal on said mutilated, lost, stolen or destroyed Note shall be due within fifteen days of receipt of the written request of the registered owner for authentication and delivery of a new Note, payment therefor shall be made as scheduled in lieu of issuing a new Note. In every case the registered owner shall certify in writing as to the destruction, theft, or loss of such Note, and shall provide indemnification satisfactory

to the County and to the Note Registrar, if required by the County and the Note Registrar.

Any notice to the contrary notwithstanding, the County and all of the officials, employees, and agents thereof, including the Note Registrar, may deem and treat the registered owners of the Note as the absolute owners thereof for all purposes, including, but not limited to, payment of the principal thereof and the interest thereon, regardless of whether such payment shall then be overdue.

Section 11. Authentication. Only a Note as shall have endorsed thereon a certificate of authentication, substantially in the form set forth in Exhibit "A" hereto duly executed by the Note Registrar shall be entitled to the rights, benefits, and security of this Resolution. No Note shall be valid or obligatory for any purpose unless, and until, such certificate of authentication shall have been duly executed by the Note Registrar. Such executed certificate of authentication by the Note Registrar upon any such Note shall be conclusive evidence that such Note has been duly authenticated and delivered under this Resolution as of the date of authentication.

Section 12. Source of Payment. The Note, as to both principal and interest, shall be payable from ad valorem taxes (together with other funds of the County legally available therefor) to be levied on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the County without limitation as to time, rate or amount. Said Note shall be a direct general obligation of the County, for which the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the Note, the full faith and credit of the County is irrevocably pledged.

Section 13. Levy of Taxes. For the purpose of providing for the payment of the principal of and interest on the Note to the extent required there shall be levied in each year in which such Note shall be outstanding a direct tax on all taxable property in the County, fully sufficient to pay, together with other funds of the County legally available therefor, all such principal and interest falling due prior to the time of collection of the next succeeding tax levy. Said tax shall be assessed, collected, and paid at the time, and in the same manner, as the other taxes of said County, shall be in addition to all other taxes, and shall be without limitation as to time, rate, or amount. principal or interest falling due at any time when there shall be insufficient funds on hand from such tax levy for the payment thereof shall be paid from the general fund or other available funds of the County, but reimbursement therefor may be made from the taxes herein provided when the same shall have been collected.

Section 14. Approval of Director of Local Finance. Anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding, no Note authorized under this Resolution shall be issued, sold, or delivered, unless and until such Note shall first have been duly approved by the Director of Local Finance of the State of Tennessee as provided by Section 9-21-601, Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended. The County Executive, County Clerk, and County Attorney are hereby authorized to take or cause to be taken

such steps as are necessary to obtain such approval. After the issuance and sale of the Note, and for each year that the Note is outstanding, the County shall submit its annual budget to the Director of Local Finance for approval immediately upon the County's adoption of the budget.

Section 15. Sale of Note. The Notes herein are authorized to be sold at public sale, or to be sold at private sale (upon approval of the Director of Local Finance), by the County Executive on terms and conditions not inconsistent with this Resolution, but the Note shall not be sold for less than par value thereof.

Section 16. Disposition of Note Proceeds. The proceeds from the sale of the Note shall be paid to the official of the county designated by law as the custodian of the funds thereof to be deposited in a special fund known as the "1994 General Obligation Note Fund" (the "Note Fund") to be kept separate and apart from all other funds of the county. The monies in the Note Fund shall be disbursed solely to finance the Project. Money in the Note Fund may be invested and shall be secured in the manner prescribed by applicable statutes relative to the investment and securing of public or trust funds.

Section 17. Designation of Notes as Qualified Tax-Exempt Obligations. The County hereby designates the Notes as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" within the meaning and for the purpose of Section 265(b)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), subject to a certification of the County Executive that it is reasonably anticipated that the amount of "qualified tax-exempt obligations" within the meaning of Section 265(b)(3) of the Code which will be issued during the calendar year of 1994 by the County as a qualified small issuer will not exceed \$10,000,000.

Section 18. Non-Arbitrage Certification. The County certifies and covenants with the owners of the Notes that so long as the principal of any Note remains unpaid, moneys on deposit in any fund or account in connection with the Notes, whether or not such moneys were derived from the proceeds of the sale of the Notes or from any other source, will not be used in a manner which will cause the Notes to be "arbitrage bonds" within the meaning of Section 148 of the Code, as amended, and any lawful regulations promulgated thereunder, as the same presently exist, or may from time to time hereafter be amended, supplemented or revised. The County reserves the right, however, to make any investment of such moneys permitted by Tennessee law and this Resolution if, when and to the extent that said Section 148 or regulations promulgated thereunder shall be repealed or relaxed or shall be held void by final decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, but only if any investment made by virtue of such repeal, relaxation or decision would not, in the opinion of counsel of recognized competence in such matters, result in making the interest on the Notes subject to inclusion in the gross income of the holders thereof for federal income tax purposes.

The County covenants that it shall comply with Section 148(f) of the Code, unless legally exempted therefrom and it represents that in the event it shall be required by Section 148(f) of the Code to pay Rebutable Arbitrage as defined in the regulations promulgated under the Code to the United States Government it will make such payments as and when required by said Section 148(f) and will take such other actions as shall be necessary or permitted to prevent the interest on the Notes from becoming subject to inclusion in federal gross income of the owners of the Notes for federal income tax purposes. The County further covenants that it will not take any action that will cause the interest on the Notes to be subject to inclusion in gross income of the owners thereof for federal income tax purposes under Sections 103 and 141 through 150 of the Code.

Section 19. Resolution a Contract. The provisions of this Resolution shall constitute a contract between the County and the owner of the Note, and after the issuance of the Note, no change, variation, or alteration of any kind in the provisions of this Resolution shall be made in any manner, until such time as all installments of the principal and the interest on the Note shall have been paid in full or consent of the registered owners of the Note has been obtained; provided, however, that the County is hereby authorized to make such amendments to the Resolution as will not impair the rights of the owners of the Note.

Section 20. No Action to be Taken Affecting Validity of the Note. The Board hereby covenants and agrees that it will not take any action, that would in any manner affect the validity of the Note or limit the rights and remedies of the owners from time to time of such Note or affect the tax exempt status of the interest payable thereon.

Section 21. Miscellaneous Acts. The County Executive, the County Clerk, the County Trustee, and all other appropriate officials of the County are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to do any and all such acts and things, and to execute, acknowledge, and deliver all such documents, instruments, and certifications, specifically including but not limited to, making arbitrage certifications in connection with the purchase of the Note, in addition to those acts, things, documents, instruments and certifications hereinbefore authorized and approved, as may in their discretion, be necessary or desirable to implement or comply with the intent of this Resolution; or any of the documents herein authorized and approved; or for the authorization, issuance and delivery of the Note.

Section 22. Failure to Present Note. In the event any Note shall not be presented for payment when the principal becomes due at maturity and in the event monies sufficient to pay such Note shall be held by the Note Registrar for the benefit of the registered owner thereof, all liability of the County to such registered owner for the payment of such Note shall forthwith cease, terminate, and be completely discharged. Thereupon, the Note Registrar shall hold such monies, without liability for interest thereon, for the benefit of the owner of such Note who shall thereafter be

restricted exclusively to such monies for any claim under the Resolution or on, or with respect to, said Note, subject to escheat or other similar law, and any applicable statute of limitation.

Section 23. Payments Due on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays. Whenever the interest on or principal of any Note is due on a Saturday or Sunday or, at the place designated for payment, a legal holiday or a day on which banking institutions are authorized by law to close, then the payment of the interest on, or the principal of, such Note need not be made on such date but must be made on the next succeeding day not a Saturday, Sunday, or a legal holiday or a day upon which banking institutions are authorized by law to close, with the same force and effect as if made on the date of maturity; and no interest shall accrue for the period after such date.

Section 24. No Recourse Under Resolution or on Note. All stipulations, promises, agreements, and obligations of the County contained in this Resolution shall be deemed to be the stipulations, promises, agreements, and obligations of the County and not of any officer, director, or employee of the County in his or her individual capacity, and no recourse shall be had for the payment of the principal of or interest on the Note or for any claim based thereon or under this Resolution against any officer, director, or employee of the County or against any official or individual executing the Note.

Section 25. Severability. If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions hereof.

Section 26. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions and Effective Date. All resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, and this Resolution shall be in effect as of the date of its adoption the welfare of the County requiring it.

In the event that any amount payable hereunder as interest shall at any time exceed the rate of interest lawfully chargeable on this Note under applicable law, any such excess shall, to the extent of such excess, be applied against the principal hereof as a prepayment thereof without penalty, and such excess shall not be considered to be interest. All rates of interest specified herein shall be computed on the basis of a

three hundred sixty (360) day year composed of twelve (12) months of thirty (30) days each.

The principal hereof and interest hereon, shall bear interest from and after the due date (whether by acceleration, demand, or otherwise) at the same rate of interest payable on the principal hereof.

This Note is known as "General Obligation Capital Outlay Notes, Series 1994" (the "Note"), issued by the County in the aggregate principal amount of _____ . The Note is issued for the purpose of financing certain public works projects, including the asphalt pavement and/or asphalt resurfacing of certain roads in Lawrence County, Tennessee, is authorized by an appropriate resolution of the Board of Commissioners and particularly that certain Resolution of the Board of Commissioners adopted on September 26, 1994, entitled "Resolution of Lawrence County, Tennessee, authorizing the issuance of an interest bearing General Obligation Capital Outlay Notes, Series 1994, in an amount not to exceed \$607,000.00, and providing for the payment of said Note," as such Resolution may be from time to time amended or supplemented in accordance with its terms (such Resolution as so amended or supplemented, being herein called, the "Note Resolution"), and is issued pursuant to, and in full compliance with, the Constitution and the statutes of the State of Tennessee, including, but not limited to, Title 9, Chapter 21, Parts 1, 4, and 6, of Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended (the "Act"). Copies of said Note Resolution are on file at the office of the County Clerk of the County, and reference is hereby made to said Note Resolution and the Act, for a more complete statement of the terms and conditions upon which the Note is issued thereunder, the rights, duties, immunities, and obligations of the County, and the rights of the Registered Owner hereof.

This Note is a direct general obligation of the County payable from ad valorem taxes (together with other funds of the County legally available therefore) to be levied on all taxable property in the County without limitation as to time, rate, or amount. For the prompt payment of this Note, both principal and interest, as the same shall become due, the full faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

This Note is transferable by the Registered Owner hereof in person or by his, her, or is attorney or legal representative at the office of the Note Registrar, but only in the manner and subject to the limitations and conditions provided in the Note Resolution and upon surrender and cancellation of this Note. Upon any such transfer, the County shall execute and the Note Registrar shall authenticate and deliver in exchange for this Note a new fully registered note or notes, registered in the name of the transferee, in authorized denominations, in an aggregate principal amount equal to the principal amount of this Note, of the same maturity and bearing interest at the same rate. For every exchange or transfer of notes, whether temporary or definitive, the County and the Note Registrar may make a charge, unless otherwise herein to the contrary expressly provided, sufficient to pay for any tax, fee, or other governmental

charge required to be paid with respect to such exchange or transfer, all of which taxes, fees, or other governmental charges shall be paid to the County by which taxes, fees, or other governmental charges shall be paid to the County by the person or entity requesting such exchange or transfer as a condition precedent to the exercise of the privilege of making such exchange or transfer.

The County and the Note Registrar may deem and treat the person or entity in whose name this Note is registered as the absolute owner hereof, whether such Note shall be overdue or note, for the purpose of making payment of the principal of and interest on, this Note and for all other purposes. All such payments so made shall be valid and effectual to satisfy and discharge the liability upon this Note to the extent of the sum or sums so paid, and neither the County nor the Note Registrar shall be affected by any notice to the contrary.

The Note is issuable only as a fully registered Note, without coupons. At the office of the Note Registrar, in the manner and subject to the limitations, conditions, and charges provided in the Note Resolution, a fully registered Note may be exchanged for an equal aggregate principal amount of a fully registered Note of the same maturity, of authorized denominations, and bearing interest at the same rate.

The Note shall be subject to redemptive prior to maturity without premium at any time.

This Note shall have all the qualities and incidents of, and shall be a negotiable instrument under, the Uniform Commercial Code of the State of Tennessee, subject only to provisions respecting registration of such Note. This Note is issued with the intent that the laws of the State of Tennessee shall govern its construction.

Resolution to approve proposal of the Department of Transportation of the State of Tennessee presented to Lawrence County, Tennessee for the construction of project designated as NO.DS-NH-6(28), 50001-2246-14, that is ascribed as U.S. 43(SR-6) from Busby Road in Loretto to the five lane section in Leoma in Lawrence County, Tennessee.

P R O P O S A L

OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE
TO THE COUNTY OF LAWRENCE, TENNESSEE:

The DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION of the State of Tennessee, hereinafter "DEPARTMENT", proposes to construct a project designated as No. DS-NH-6(28), 50001-2246-14, that is described as U.S. 43 (SR-6), From Busby Road In Loretto To The 5-Lane Section In Leoma in the COUNTY of LAWRENCE, hereinafter COUNTY, provided the COUNTY agrees to cooperate with the DEPARTMENT as set forth in this proposal, so that the general highway program may be carried out in accordance with the intent of the General Assembly of the State.

Accordingly, if the COUNTY will agree:

1. That in the event any civil actions in inverse condemnation or for damages are instituted by reason of the DEPARTMENT, or its contractor, going upon the highway right-of-way and easements, and constructing said project in accordance with the plans and as necessary to make the completed project functional, it will notify in writing the Attorney General of the State, whose address is 404 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-0487, of the institution of each civil action, the complaint and all subsequent pleadings, within ten (10) days after the service of each of the same, under penalty of defending such actions and paying any judgments which result therefrom at its own expense; and

2. To close or otherwise modify any of its roads or other public ways if indicated on the project plans, as provided by law; and

3. To transfer or cause to be transferred to the DEPARTMENT without cost to it, all land owned by the COUNTY or by any of its instrumentalities as required for right-of-way or easement purposes, provided such land is being used or dedicated for road or other public way purposes; and

4. Where privately, publicly or cooperatively owned utility lines, facilities and systems for producing, transmitting or distributing communications, power, electricity, light, heat, gas, oil, crude products, water, steam, waste, storm water not connected with highway drainage, and other similar commodities, including publicly owned facilities such as fire and police signal systems and street lighting systems are located within the right of way of any road or other public way owned by the COUNTY, or any of its instrumentalities, the COUNTY agrees that it will take action necessary to require the removal or adjustment of any of the above described facilities as would conflict with the construction of the project. But the foregoing may not be a duty of the COUNTY since it shall become operative only after the DEPARTMENT has been unsuccessful in its efforts to provide for said removals or adjustments for the benefit of the COUNTY.

The foregoing does not apply to those utility facilities which are owned by the COUNTY or one of its instrumentalities, it being understood that the COUNTY has the duty to relocate or adjust such facilities, if required, provided the COUNTY is

notified to do so by the DEPARTMENT with detailed advice as to this duty of the COUNTY; and

5. To maintain any frontage road to be constructed as part of the project; and

6. That after the project is completed and open to traffic, to accept for jurisdiction and maintenance such parts of any existing DEPARTMENT highway to be replaced by the project, as shown on the attached map; and

7. That the COUNTY will make no changes or alter any segment of a road on its road system that lies within the limits of the right-of-way acquired for any interchange to be constructed as part of the project and will not permit the installation or relocation of any utility facilities within the right-of-way of any such a segment of one of its roads without first obtaining the approval of the DEPARTMENT; and

8. That no provision hereof shall be construed as changing the maintenance responsibility of the COUNTY for such part of the project as may presently be on its highway, street, road or bridge system; and

9. That it is understood and agreed between the DEPARTMENT and the COUNTY that all traffic control signs for the control of traffic on a street under the jurisdiction of the COUNTY and located within the DEPARTMENT's right-of-way shall be maintained and replaced by the COUNTY; and

10. That when traffic control devices for the direction or warning of traffic, lighting of roadways or signing, or any of them, which are operated or function by the use of electric

current are constructed or installed as part of the project, they will be furnished with electricity and maintained by the COUNTY.

11. If, as a result of acquisition and use of right of way for the project, any building improvements become in violation of a COUNTY setback/building line requirement, the COUNTY agrees to waive enforcement of the COUNTY setback/building line requirement and take other proper governmental action therefor.

The acceptance of this proposal shall be evidenced by the passage of a resolution, or by other proper governmental action, which shall incorporate this proposal verbatim, or by reference thereto. Thereafter, the DEPARTMENT will acquire the right-of-way and easements, construct the project and defend any inverse condemnation or damage civil actions of which the Attorney General has received the notice and pleadings provided for herein.

The project plans hereinbefore identified by number and description are incorporated herein by reference and shall be considered a part of this proposal, including any revisions or amendments thereto, provided a copy of each is furnished the COUNTY.
