



SECTION 1: The speed limit on the West Side Road to the Giles County line, and the entire length of the Lantz Road shall be reduced to 40 miles miles per hour.



The Board of Trustees of the Lawrence County Public Library met in regular session at the library on March 7, 1995. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. Those present were Teresa Newton, Debbie Ryder, Loretta Washburn, Mary Benson, Donette Sellers, Sandy Curtis, Bobby Alford, Ron Evans, Danny Pettus, Anita Belew, Jane Hairrell and Marion Bryant.

Minutes of the January, 1995, meeting were approved with the following corrections and amendments:

1. On page 1, delete the last sentence of paragraph two.
2. On page 3, under the Purchase of Computer Equipment paragraph change the date to 1994/95.
3. On page 4, the third paragraph, delete the last sentence and amend that motion was made and seconded that Teresa, at her discretion, be allowed to charge a fee or cash deposit-fully refundable- but if a fine is due, the fine may be deducted from the deposit before the deposit is returned. Motion carried.

(PAGES OF CORRECTED MINUTES ARE ATTACHED)

Report of the Budget Committee:

Teresa gave each board member a copy of the proposed budget for the fiscal year 1995/96 accompanied by a detailed explanation of the increases. Ron Evans from the Budget Committee presented the proposed budget to the Board. Attention was called to the 4% raise for current employees. It is possible that the raise will not occur but this will have to be discussed with the County Commissioners. The budget also includes employee expenses of insurance, unemployment, FICA and workers' compensation not previously charged to our allocation of funds. Personnel expense is a 14.2% increase from our 1994/95 budget. The floor was opened for discussion. After discussion, motion was made and seconded that the proposed budget be accepted. Motion carried.

Report on the Building Project:

The architect has addressed the Fire Marshall's recommendations and returned the plans to the Fire Marshall's office. Teresa had spoken with Mr. Beasley and he felt like everything was proceeding on schedule. Teresa said that bid documents should be going out in the near future. The architect that has been working on the building plans has left the firm but does plan to continue with our building project. It was suggested that the Board try to come up with a unique idea to let the public know construction is beginning on the addition.

Civil Rights Compliance:

Marion Bryant gave copies to each board member of the following documents: Lawrence County Public Library Assurance of Compliance Under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; An Explanation of Title VI Assurance Form; Title VI Discrimination Complaint Form; Non-Discrimination Policy Statement Tennessee State Library and Archives Civil Rights Act of 1964 Title VI Implementation Plan (Public Library Boards); Tennessee Public Library Demographic Profile Form; Lawrence County Public Library, Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title VI, Data Collection Form. Marion then explained that the Board needed to adopt the Assurance of Compliance, adopt the Discrimination Complaint Form and appoint someone to receive the discrimination complaints. Motion was made and seconded that the Lawrence County Board of Trustees adopt the Assurance of Compliance under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 in its entirety and that Teresa Newton be authorized to receive any discrimination complaints. Motion carried. Loretta Washburn, Library Board Chair, then executed the Assurance of Compliance.

Appoint members to the following committees:

The following board members agreed to serve on the listed committees:

Long Range Plan-Ron Evans, Bobby Alford, Loretta Washburn, Teresa Newton and Jane Hairrell.

Emergency Preparedness Plan-Anita Belew, Danny Pettus, Teresa Newton, and Loretta Washburn.

Policy Review Committee-Mary Benson, Donette Sellers, Sandy Curtis, Teresa Newton, and Loretta Washburn.

TLA Registration:

Motion was made and seconded that the library close Thursday, March 30, 1995, in order that the entire staff might attend the TLA Convention/Seminar scheduled on that date. Motion carried.

Appreciation Day Meal:

Motion was made and seconded that the Library Board of Trustees again host a dinner for the Lawrence County Commissioners on their regular meeting date in May. Motion carried. Complete plans will be made at our May meeting.

Terms of Trustees:

Board members Danny Pettus, Bobby Alford, Donette Sellers, and Jane Hairrell agreed to serve as trustees for a second three-year term.

The floor was then opened for discussion in regard to the expiration of Loretta Washburn's second term on June 30, 1995. The Tennessee Code does not limit the terms of board members but Lawrence County's Inter-Local Agreement provides that two three-year terms can be served and the board member can not be reappointed. All library board members are in agreement that, at the present time, we do not have the time to orient a new person to the Board. Ron Evans said he would request a special dispensation to allow Mrs. Washburn to serve one more year. As Vice-Chair, Bobby Alford was requested to preside over the vote. Motion was made and seconded that the Lawrence County Board of Commissioners be requested to extend the time of Loretta Washburn's term as Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Lawrence County Public Library for one year thus allowing her continued participation in the Building Project. Motion carried unanimously.

Library Report:

Teresa has spoken to a computer firm in Pulaski about all that is needed for our circulation system to go on line. This will cost approximately \$800 over out budgeted amount. Also, the terminals will have to be secured through the bid process. Teresa thinks that, due to the construction that will be going on, the dust, etc., it might be a good idea to delay the purchase of this equipment until construction is complete. Matching grant funds up to \$2,200 for equipment are available from the State and Teresa will fill out a grant application. If awarded to our library, we would purchase the equipment now.

The library has had great success from the letters Ron Evans sent in regard to long-overdue materials. Teresa has given him more names for letters. It was suggested that the library be allowed to show its appreciation to Ron's secretarial staff.

Murray Ohio Manufacturing Company has responded to our latest request with a donation of \$10,000.00 All board members agreed that recognition should be given to Murray Ohio Manufacturing Company for their generous contributions to our Building Fund. This will be decided at a later date.

Regional Director's Report:

Marion gave a progress report on Lynette Sloan's son. He is now at home but will leave May 29th for a long-term type clinic for at least nine months to two years. Cards are always appreciated.

The Trustees Workshop is scheduled for June 8th and 9th in Murfreesboro. Board members were urged to make plans to attend and Marion will have more information later.

Marion left a form with Teresa for a nominee for the Sequoyah Literacy Award, if we have a nominee.

Federal funding for libraries may be eliminated in the next budget.


This would affect construction, automation, and materials purchases. We may need to lobby for library funding and help our legislators understand what our libraries are doing for everyone.

REPORT FROM THE LIBRARY
April 25, 1995

As usual, the time between meetings has flown by. This is a busy time of the year--both with patrons and with projects which are due by the end of the fiscal year..

The state auditor has been in the county, and spent time with us at the library. She mentioned a couple of minor things we may have to deal with, but did not indicate any major questions with our records. I don't have any idea when the full report will come down.

Maggie Williams was on leave without pay with medical problems. She returned to work for a time, but leaves today for tests at the Mayo Clinic. We hope they will be able to relieve her back problems.

Shirley McCafferty and I attended the housewarming for Ron's new home. It is a beautiful place. Ron told us that he would like to have a meeting of the board there during the summer.

I have been spending some time investigating what is on the internet. As of now, I have located some interesting and fun things--but not how to access information which would benefit our patrons. The workshop that I attended in Nashville was very informative. Maybe it will help me discover more valuable sources of info.

When the temperatures warmed up and we tried to use the air conditioner, we discovered that it was not working. Evers finally got it going, but had to order a relay switch which causes the thermostat to regulate itself. The part was installed--but is defective. A replacement is on order. The total cost of repairs is approximately \$700.

TLA was very interesting this year. Mrs. Washburn, Mary, Bobby and I were there from Wednesday through Friday. The staff came up on Thursday, and attended three sessions and toured the exhibits. We all learned new things. More will be reported at our meeting.

I was back in Nashville on April 3 for computer training. The new update of our circulation software was due to be shipped on The 15th of this month. When it arrives, we will begin extracting our records from the state-wide database and building our patron records.

I did send in an application for matching grant funds for the purchase of additional computer equipment. No announcements have been made about which libraries will be awarded grant funds. First priority will be given to libraries who are not yet connected to the internet or which have not begun recon for circulation. Second priority is for additional equipment. We may have news by the time of our meeting.

Bids were opened on April 18 for our building project. I have talked with some of you since then, so you know that the day was disappointing. Rather than try to explain in a written report, I will wait until our meeting to go into more detail.

You may have noticed that I have not done a newsletter for the month of April. I hope to have one printed by next week. Two items of interest are the display of items from India provided by Mrs. Rita Shah, and the Saturday story hours. Mrs. Shah's display, like the previous two about foreign countries, has been very well received. Unfortunately, we do not have a new one definitely lined up for May. If you know someone who might be able to provide a display, please let Shirley know. The Future Teachers Association from LCHS has conducted a Saturday storyhour on the second Saturday of each month during this school year. Their last one is scheduled for May 13. The students have put a lot of thought and time into this project--I only wish that the programs had been better attended. Perhaps we can talk with the FTA from Loretto High and see if they would be interested in trying a similar project next year.

I look forward to seeing each of you at our meeting.

MINUTES OF AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION COMMITTEE
April 25, 1995

The Committee met at the Extension Office at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 25, 1995, with the following members present: Donna Crews, Jim Belew, Steve Hill, Tommy Moore, and L. C. Parrott. Others present were Extension agents, Zorah Messer, Bill Sampson, and Wayne Jackson. Chairman Steve Hill called the meeting to order. Jim Belew read the minutes of the last meeting; they were approved as read.

Wayne Jackson presented the budget for the fiscal year July 1, 1995 - June 30, 1996. Wayne informed the Committee that the University would like to see all salaries funded at 30 percent of the total salaries. Some salaries run over 30 percent, some under. One salary is funded 100 percent by the county. The total support from the county at this point in time is \$114,242. The motion was made by L. C. Parrott to accept the budget as presented; it was seconded by Jim Belew; the motion passed.

Wayne also presented the evaluation form to the Committee. The purpose of the form is to make the present programs offered by the Extension Service more effective. He suggested the forms be given to the groups worked with by Extension. The form was approved by the Committee.

Bill Sampson informed the Committee of some negative feedback he is getting in the county about 4-H. He feels the image needs to be improved. Bill designed a plan and presented it to Mr. Gordon Pafford and other District Extension Supervisors. After much discussion they approved the plan and would like to make it a pilot for the state, if the Committee approves. Bill suggested that he and Ms. Messer go beyond the 4-H meetings and do some extra classroom programs on different subjects. He has begun some afterschool programs with some hands-on experience which have proven successful. This would entail afterschool clubs and going into the classrooms with programs to let the students become more informed about agriculture. Steve Hill suggested we explore this very aggressively and would like the support of the entire Extension Service. Tommy Moore recommended that Mr. Sampson and Ms. Messer meet with some school personnel to present the plan and get their support. Upon receiving the schools' support, the Committee is in favor of implementing the program. L. C. Parrott made the motion to accept the program; Donna Crews seconded it. The Committee requested the entire Extension staff support this program. The motion passed.

Meeting adjourned.
