

RESOLUTION TO REDUCE SPEED LIMIT ON OAKS STREET IN SUMMERTOWN

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 55-8-153 authorizes county legislative bodies to prescribe such lower speed limits as it may deem appropriate on any road being maintained by the county, and

WHEREAS, the county legislative body of Lawrence County desires that the speed limit on Oaks Street in Summertown be reduced to 35 miles per hour to protect the safety of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of Lawrence County meeting this 24th day of July, 1995, that:

SECTION 1: The speed limit on Oaks Street in Summertown shall be reduced to 35 miles per hour.

SECTION 2: That appropriate road signs be posted to give notice of such reduced speed limit.


SECTION 3: This resolution shall take place upon adoption, the general welfare requiring it.



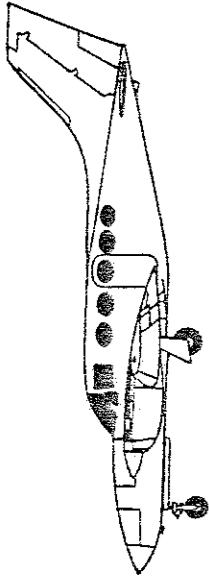

Jim Buie made a motion to turn down the pilots request for the ability to purchase movies on the television. They said they would reimburse the airport for the cost. Board members felt like this would be hard to control since the Managers are out mowing so much and could not keep track of them. The motion was seconded by Jim Tiedjens. The motion carried.

April 3, 1995

The Board of Directors of the Lawrence County Senior Citizens Center met in regular session on April 3, 1995. Present for this meeting were: Gary Adair, James Reeves, Mickey Bradley, John Jackson, Alton Turnbow, Loretto Washburn, Jackie Bailey, G.A. Duke, Jerry Putman, Darrin McKamie, Dempsey Holder and Director Corinne Perry. Absent board members were Daphene Cope and Gerry Geho.

Chariman Gary Adair called the meeting to order. Alton Turnbow led the group in prayer.

The minutes of the last board meeting were mailed with the agenda for this board meeting. Loretto Washburn made a motion to approve the minutes as written. This was seconded by Jackie Bailey. Motion carried.

The next order of business was to present Lawrenceburg's leading ticket salesman, Landon Cole, with a certificate of appreciation for his help during the Irish Stew fundraiser.

OLD BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS:

Corinne presented to the board the bill from Simmons and Sprouse Insurance Agency for the current years automobile insurance and general liability insurance in the amount of \$9097. The board was informed that this is the lowest rates obtainable. One local company, Markus Insurance, is working on trying to get a package deal which might save the Center a little money, but this cannot be accomplished soon enough to keep the Center covered. Board members asked if there is money available in Center funds for this payment and they were informed that there is money for this insurance since this is paid with Transportation funds. A motion was made by G. A. Duke and seconded by Jerry Putman to approve this expenditure. The motion carried.

Corinne informed the board of the need for a change in the policy regarding comp-time based on information learned at a seminar on legal issues in the workplace. At that seminar a representative of the Department of Labor related that DOL regulations require employers to pay at least 1 1/2 times the regular rate of pay for any hours worked over 40 hours in a week. "Comp time" is not an option for any organization except for governmental agencies.

Dempsey Holder made a motion that we simply need to remove the current statement regarding "comp time" from the Personnel Policy. The motion was seconded by Darrin McKamie. The motion carried.

A revised budget for FY 1994-95 was presented to the board for approval. Most of the changes involved the increase in Transportation/SCATS expenses and revenue. Dempsey Holder made a motion made to approve the revision. Mickey Bradley seconded it and the motion carried.

The next item of business was to change the work of the activities coordinator from a contract situation back to an hourly wage position effective July 1 with the beginning of the new fiscal year. It was pointed out to the board that since Gean Bryant is not actually in a trade or business offering services to the public, it was not felt that this would meet IRS requirements of being a valid contract situation, and is more correctly an hourly position. Corinne also told the board that Gean has been a real asset to the Center in developing new activities and programs and that she is, in fact, producing enough income through some of the trips and activities to pay her own wages. Gean would be a part-time employee, working 20 hours per week as the health activities instructor and activities coordinator at the rate of \$6.50 per hour. She would not be eligible for paid vacation or sick leave, but would be granted time off without pay when needed. Jerry Putman made a motion to approve this change. Dempsey Holder seconded the motion and it carried.

Corinne presented to the board a request for pay increases for employees at the Center. She told the board that the yearly cost of living increase given State employees was 2.8%. Instead of this 2.8% increase, she requested that the Drivers' and Transportation Coordinator's rate of pay be increased to \$6.00 per hour due to the fact that the work week had been reduced to 37 1/2 hours. She recommended the Secretary receive the standard 2.8% increase. These pay increases would be effective July 1, 1995. Alton Turnbo made a motion to approve these raises contingent up on funds being available to pay the requested increases. The motion was seconded by John Jackson and carried.

Corinne then ask the board to approve a pay increase for herself as Director to be equal with the salary approved for the prior director, which equaled \$8.00 per hour based on a 40-hour week, or annual salary of \$16,640 to be effective July 1, 1995. Dempsey Holder made a motion to approve this pay increase contingent upon funds being available. G. A. Duke seconded the motion and it carried.

The Board was reminded that according to the bylaws the Center needs a board member who is either an attorney or CPA. Corinne told the Board that she had spoken with Ronald Evans, a local attorney, who is willing to serve on the board. By adding him as a member we would need to reduce the Board by

one "at large" member. Alton Turnbo had discussed earlier that he was not always able to attend meetings and would be willing to step down. The Nominating Committee will need to meet to discuss this proposal and, if so desired, to nominate Mr. Evans for board membership. This would then be brought before the Board in July and to the membership for final approval.

After the insurance expenses and the match money for the new bus and vans have been paid, Corinne would like for the board to discuss the amount that should be kept in the checking account. She would like the board to be thinking about how to invest any amount over the approved amount to be kept in the checking account.

Corinne then ask that we establish a Building Improvement Committee. The building is in need of an elevator, carpet/tile needs to be replaced, and some other things are needed to brighten up the Center. She is aware that has been State money awarded to Centers for renovations, etc., and we will try to get some State money to do these things. G. A. Duke, Dempsey Holder, Loretto Washburn and Mickey Bradley volunteered for the committee. A motion was made to accept individuals as a committee. The motion was seconded and passed by unanimous decision.

Also, we need a committee to discuss the development of additional funding for the Center in the future. There was a cut in this year's funds and there will probably be a cut in the next fiscal year also. Also, some of the funds approved for this fiscal year from the County have not been received to date. For this reason the Board was asked to select a committee to study the development of alternative types of funding. Jerry Putman, Darrin McKamie and Mickey Bradley were asked to serve. The Board approved this committee by unanimous decision.

The Board was presented with a copy of the Director's report which was briefly discussed. Corinne asked the Board members to read this report and if there were any questions or comments to contact her for further discussion. (A copy of the Director's Report is attached as a part of the minutes of this meeting.)

The meeting was opened for any further discussion. As there was no discussion, Gary asked for a motion to adjourn. A motion was made and seconded and the meeting was adjourned.

FYI ITEMS:

Water Aerobics: Still going great! New session will begin 4/20/95.

Shuffleboard: Enthusiasm is growing in this activity. Our players received trophies in both the February and March tournaments. At the March tournament at Hohenwald, Lawrence County players dominated the doubles playoffs, (literally), so we brought home both the first and second place trophies in doubles competition.

New Members: We're still signing up new members and welcoming back some who have been members in the past.

Trips/tours: Interest in our trips/tours is high. We had a temporary setback concerning our trips. The man who was supposedly going to work with us, for some reason just never contacted us after the first of the year, so we have had to get some plans of our own together, and are still working on trips for the rest of the year. We did get a trip together and went to Crossville to see the play "Smoke on the Mountain" in March. The Director took a couple of days off and went with this group (as a paying passenger) on this two-day one-night trip. We thoroughly enjoyed this trip and there seemed to be good interest in additional trips sponsored by the Center.

Nutrition: There are still some problems in nutrition. The dishwasher in the kitchen finally died (of old age I'm sure), and this has caused some inconvenience. Since the kitchen does not have a three-compartment sink, it does not meet the requirements to hand-wash dishes, necessitating the use of plastic eating utensils and drinking cups. Some of the members do not particularly like this. It is my understanding that the County has agreed to buy a new dishwasher, but this has not been done yet. There are still complaints from the volunteers concerning the Site Manager. At the recent Site Manager's meeting I talked with Beth Roberson, Joyce Konig, and Anne Hughes concerning the need to clean the kitchen, dining room and restrooms in a little better fashion.

Fundraiser

We had a good fundraising event on March 17 when we served a stew lunch. We cleared almost \$500, which may not be an awful lot of money, but will certainly help. What impressed me as much as the money we made was the way everyone seemed to enjoy themselves. A few suggested we do something like that every month. The stew was, in fact, very delicious, thanks to the help of a lady, Mrs. Dene Taylor, who is well known for preparing food for large crowds. (Dene did a great deal of the cooking for the emergency shelters during the infamous Ice Storm of 1994.) Dene is our SCATS bus driver, and is always willing to do anything else we need done.

Condition of Juanita Olive:

Driver Juanita Olive returned to work in the latter part of February, and seems to be getting along very well. I'm certainly glad to have her back and able to drive.

Another driver has heart attack

This past Friday, March 31, one of our part-time drivers, John Keller, suffered a heart attack and is currently in Baptist Hospital in Nashville. I certainly hope that his condition improves quickly and completely, but in the meantime, "Yours Truly" will be back to helping out with driving when everyone else is busy.

Transportation Coordinator:

I hired Barbara (Bobbie) Gist as the new full-time Transportation Coordinator, and she is doing an outstanding job in all aspects of her duties. Bobbie had a spell of sickness which took her out of action for about 3 weeks, but she is back at work and doing her usual good job.

Budget revision:

The budget revision has been completed and presented as an item of business in this board meeting.

Change in method of reporting

After a discussion with Sanford Potts of the South Central Tennessee Development District, we will be reporting our Transportation and SCATS services differently than it has been done in the past. Previously we were reporting all trips made outside Lawrence County as SCATS trips, even if done in a Section 18 van. (This is the way I had been instructed by a prior employee of the Development District.) Actually the only trips that should be reported as "SCATS" are those made in the "SCATS" Bus. Accordingly, there will be a shift of revenues and units of service from SCATS to "Transportation". This will become noticeable in the fund balances as the revenues from our TennCare contract are received. There will be less going into "SCATS" and more going into "Transportation".

New Vehicles

I was jumping for joy (literally) recently when I was informed by Sanford Potts that he was getting the larger capacity SCATS bus I wanted (20 passenger), AND, on top of that he was also getting us TWO new vans to replace our two older vans, both of which have over 100,000 miles on them. These vehicles were ordered on March 17, and I'm hoping by the end of April or maybe in May to receive these. This is going to help us greatly by cutting down on the repair bills we have been experiencing for the past year or so.

Changes in Driver Scheduling

After Juanita returned to work, we had two full-time drivers on duty, and since there is not enough local driving to keep 2 drivers busy, I had to make some changes in scheduling. On some days there would be few (or no) medical/TennCare trips to do and there would be up to 3 or 4 hours of the day with nothing for the drivers to do. To remedy this problem we began a method of scheduling the full-time drivers for much of the out-of-town work, and using the part-time drivers to fill in when shorter runs are needed. Also, to keep each driver's hours under 40, I cut back the hours from 40 to 37.5 by requiring employees to sign out for a 30-minute lunch period. Some of the employees were a little upset about this change, but I explained to them that it simply is not possible to have a standard work day of 7:30 to 3:30 when our driving assignments do not all fall within those times. In our contract with TennCare we agreed to be available to transport clients from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. These hours are necessary in order to accommodate early/late appointments out of town. These out-of-town trips bring in the bulk of our revenue from TennCare. I believe the employees are adjusting to the flexible hour scheduling and that this will cut out most of the "idle time" for the drivers. Drivers are also required to clock out if there will be more than an hour between work assignments. Up to an hour, they are allowed to remain on duty as long as they are busy with transportation related work such as cleaning out their vans, cleaning windshield and windows, etc.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES
May 11, 1995

The Board of Trustees of the Lawrence County Public Library met in regular session at the library on May 11, 1995. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. Those present were Teresa Newton, Debbie Ryder, Loretta Washburn, Mary Benson, Sandy Curtis, Bobby Alford, Ron Evans, Danny Pettus, Anita Belew, Jane Hairrell and Marion Bryant.

Motion was made and seconded that the minutes of the March, 1995, meeting be approved after correcting a typing error on page four, second line. Motion carried.

UPDATE ON BUILDING PROJECT:

Three bids were received for the addition to the Lawrence County Public Library. These bids were opened in April and the bid of \$388,783.00 from Brindley Construction Company, Pulaski, was the best offer. A construction firm in Waynesboro submitted a lower bid but the contractor's license had expired. The bid from Brindley was not within our budget and Teresa, Loretta and Ron met with the architect and representatives from Brindley to discuss what costs could be cut. Teresa received a fax from Brindley suggesting the following changes which would cut approximately \$14,877.00 for the cost:

Cosmetic changes-no planters on the front, down-grade cabinets in the kitchen, use vinyl in the bathroom (not ceramic tile), wait until later to repaint the older part of the library.

Might be able to use a different grade of wiring in some sections.

The library has a \$10,000.00 contingency fund built into the bid. This amount has not been touched. Teresa has spoken with Mr. Beasley regarding an extension of time and Mr. Beasley has extended the time to spend the grant money from 6/30/95 until 6/30/96.

Lawrence County has allowed the library \$4300.00 more than their usual two-thirds share of our budget funding. The Construction Account balance on this date is \$225,478.38. The library has received \$12,000.00 in gifts since July 1, 1994, and this amount is not included in the above balance. We have paid out approximately \$25,000.00. This total includes the \$22,000.00 paid to the architectural firm of Hart, Freeland and Roberts with \$7,000.00 still due. The architect will need to draw an amended plan based on the

BRIEF REPORTS FROM TENNESSEE LIBRARY ASSOCIATION CONFERENCE:

Loretta attended the session "Hard Hats and Blue Prints on Building Projects" and said this was very informative since the speaker was recently involved in a building project. Loretta said she was assured by everyone that if you were working with Jim Beasley your budget will be fine. One of the sessions Mary attended "Order Your Furnishings the Day You Break Ground" was very good; another on "How to Evaluate Religious Materials" was excellent. The staff attended a session on "Everyone is Getting Crabber" and another on "Genealogy in Public Libraries". When we have more space for local history, Teresa can call Chuck Sherrill at the State Library and Archives for assistance and he will come down. Bobby attended a session on INTERNET. He also attended the genealogy session and thought it was very well planned. Everyone enjoyed the tour of the Ingram Book Company and were given a choice of free books so everyone brought back books.

Mary Benson has been elected to serve as Chairman of the Trustees Division of the Tennessee Library Association for the next year.

LIBRARY DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Teresa has recently learned that the UT Library School may bring its degree program out into the state. If so, Teresa may be able to start to work on her Masters next year. Classes will be offered in multiple sites across the state via teleconference classrooms. All details of the program are not complete.

Teresa attended the Budget Committee hearing last week. She presented a budget with the proposed raise for the staff and a budget without the raise. Since one committee member was not present Teresa received no indication as to what the library may expect. Teresa has not yet met with the city but it is doubtful that we can get the amount we received for the past two years. She does plan to meet with the city soon and present the budget.

Teresa applied for matching grant funds for computer equipment but we will not be getting any funds.

June 9th and 10th are the dates for the "Main Street Festival". The cost to civic or non-profit organizations for a booth on the Square

Teresa addressed the Board regarding a change in the Library's night hours and possibly re-opening the library on Monday morning. Motion was made and seconded that Teresa work on a new schedule and investigate the possibility of new hours. Motion was seconded; motion carried. Teresa will present this at our next meeting.

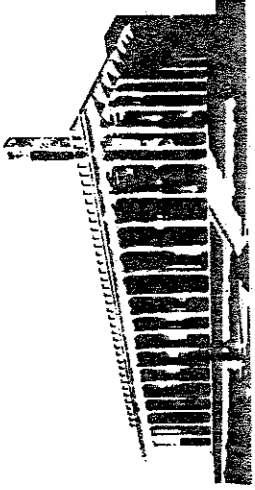

Unless either party shall notify the other party in writing at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the term, of its intention to vacate the premises, then this agreement will be automatically renewed for up to two (2) successive ten (10) year periods under the same terms and conditions contained herein. Secondly, Page 2, item 2. Utilities. City shall pay and be responsible for all electricity, water, sewer, natural gas in LCECD's use of the Space, except that LCECD shall pay to the City the sum of \$150.00 per month to defray the costs of a portion of such utilities. LCECD shall be responsible of the cost of telephone installations and service installed by LCECD. Also, Page 3, item 4. Entry. At all reasonable times, City may enter the Premises for the purpose of inspection, or making any repairs or performing any maintenance which City is required or permitted to make hereunder.

Motion made by Roy Holloway to accept these changes, seconded by Stan Methvin, passed unanimously to enter into the Agreement with those changes made.

Discussion of class comp study done to establish long term pay scale for the Address Administrator. Board discussed adopting suggested Skill Level IV under City 's salary rate chart for pay scale for the position of Address Administrator.

Motorola assured board members Lawrenceburg Communication would be their first choice to offer the maintenance service contract to. Question was directed to Layne Ezell, representative of Lawrenceburg Communications if the company would accept the service contract. Kevin Kidd informed the board that a complete equipment list was not provided by Motorola, Inc. and their price did not include the ability to upgrade to 16-channel capability without reworking the whole system and substantial cost.
