

That in the event any civil actions in inverse condemnation or for damages are instituted by reason of the DEPARTMENT, or its contractor, going upon the highway right-of-way and easements, and constructing said project in accordance with the plans and as necessary to make the completed project functional, it will notify in writing the Attorney General of the State, whose address is 404 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-0487, of the institution of each civil action, the complaint and all subsequent pleadings, within ten (10) days

after the service of each of the same, under penalty of defending such actions and paying any judgments which result therefrom at its own expense; and

2. To close or otherwise modify any of its roads or other public ways if indicated on the project plans, as provided by law; and

3. To transfer or cause to be transferred to the DEPARTMENT without cost to it, all land owned by the COUNTY or by any of its instrumentalities as required for right-of-way or easement purposes, provided such land is being used or dedicated for road or other public way purposes; and

4. Where privately, publicly or cooperatively owned utility lines, facilities and systems for producing, transmitting or distributing communications, power, electricity, light, heat, gas, oil, crude products, water, steam, waste, storm water not connected with highway drainage, and other similar commodities, including publicly owned facilities such as fire and police signal systems and street lighting systems are located within the right of way of any road or other public way owned by the COUNTY, or any of its instrumentalities, the COUNTY agrees that it will take action necessary to require the removal or adjustment of any of the above described facilities as would conflict with the construction of the project. But the foregoing may not be a duty

of the COUNTY since it shall become operative only after the DEPARTMENT has been unsuccessful in its efforts to provide for said removals or adjustments for the benefit of the COUNTY.

The foregoing does not apply to those utility facilities which are owned by the COUNTY or one of its instrumentalities, it being understood that the COUNTY has the duty to relocate or adjust such facilities, if required, provided the COUNTY is notified to do so by the DEPARTMENT with detailed advice as to this duty of the COUNTY; and

5. To maintain any frontage road to be constructed as part of the project; and

6. That after the project is completed and open to traffic, to accept for jurisdiction and maintenance such parts of any existing DEPARTMENT highway to be replaced by the project, as shown on the attached map; and

7. That the COUNTY will make no changes or alter any segment of a road on its road system that lies within the limits of the right-of-way acquired for any interchange to be constructed as part of the project and will not permit the installation or relocation of any utility facilities within the right-of-way of any such a segment of one of its roads without first obtaining the approval of the DEPARTMENT; and

8. That no provision hereof shall be construed as changing

the maintenance responsibility of the COUNTY for such part of the project as may presently be on its highway, street, road or bridge system; and

9. That it is understood and agreed between the DEPARTMENT and the COUNTY that all traffic control signs for the control of traffic on a street under the jurisdiction of the COUNTY and located within the DEPARTMENT'S right-of-way shall be maintained and replaced by the COUNTY; and

10. That when traffic control devices <sup>are</sup> for the direction or warning of traffic, lighting of roadways or signing, or any of them, which are operated or function by the use of electric current are constructed or installed as part of the project, they will be furnished with electricity and maintained by the COUNTY.

11. If, as a result of acquisition and use of right of way for the project, any building improvements become in violation of a COUNTY setback/building line requirement, the COUNTY agrees to waive enforcement of the COUNTY setback/building line requirement and take other proper governmental action therefor.

The acceptance of this proposal shall be evidenced by the passage of a resolution, or by other proper governmental action, which shall incorporate this proposal verbatim, or by reference thereto. Thereafter, the DEPARTMENT will acquire the right-of-way and easements, construct the project and defend any inverse

condemnation or damage civil actions of which the Attorney General has received the notice and pleadings provided for herein.

The project plans hereinbefore identified by number and description are incorporated herein by reference and shall be considered a part of this proposal, including any revisions or amendments thereto, provided a copy of each is furnished the COUNTY.

RESOLUTION TO ALLOW CREDIT IN THE TENNESSEE CONSOLIDATED  
RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR CERTAIN PERIODS OF MILITARY SERVICE  
RENDERED IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES IN  
ACCORDANCE WITH T.C.A. SECTION 8-34-605

WHEREAS, T.C.A. Section 8-34-605 authorizes a political subdivision participating in the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System ("the System") to allow its employees to establish retirement credit for certain military service rendered in the armed forces of the United States; and

WHEREAS, said Section allows any such employee who is a member or retired member of the System, who served in the armed forces of the United States at any time from 10/15/40 through 5/7/75, to establish retirement credit for such military service on the basis of 1 day of creditable services for each 2 days of military service rendered. The member must pay the employee contributions to establish the service based upon a contribution rate of 9% which is applied to the member's earnable compensation at the time of the claim, or if not in service at the time of the claim, the member's earnable compensation at termination of employment; and

WHEREAS, said Section also allows any such member who establishes the above military service to establish an additional 6 months of retirement credit for any military service rendered in the armed forces of the United States during the periods specified above for which the employee did not receive credit in the System. To receive such additional credit, the member must pay employee contributions for the service based upon a contribution rate of 12% which is applied to the member's earnable compensation at the time of the claim, or if not in service at the time of the claim, the member's earnable compensation at termination of employment; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-34-605 further allows any such member who served in the armed forces of the United States during a period of armed conflict, as defined in said Section, to establish retirement credit for such service without charge; and

WHEREAS, credit for any of the above military service is conditioned upon the following; (1) the credit cannot be established in any other retirement system; (2) the member was honorably discharged from such military service; (3) the credit is granted conditionally upon the member becoming vester; prior to vesting, the credit may not be used to establish

any rights under the System; and (4) the total amount of credit granted for such military service cannot exceed an aggregate of 4 years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the legislative body of Lawrence County hereby authorizes its employees to establish retirement credit for the above military service under the foregoing provisions and agrees to accept the associated liability.

2. *Maintenance and Operations.* Lessee shall at all times and at its own expense keep the Leased Equipment in good working order and operating condition, and Lessee shall furnish all replacement parts and maintenance required to preserve the Leased Equipment according to good standards of operation during this Lease. The operation and maintenance of the Leased Equipment shall be under the sole and exclusive control of Lessee, and the personnel operating and maintaining the Leased Equipment shall be the agents and employees of Lessee and not Lessor.

3. *Return of Equipment.* Upon the termination of this Lease in any manner whatsoever, or upon any default by Lessee hereunder, Lessee shall promptly deliver and return the Leased Equipment to Lessor during normal business hours at Lessee's expense, in as good order and operating condition as when initially delivered to Lessee, ordinary and reasonable wear and tear alone excepted. If Lessee fails to return the Leased Equipment, Lessor may take such steps as are necessary to repossess the same, and Lessee shall pay all reasonable expenses, including court

costs and attorney's fees, in connection with such repossession. It is expressly agreed between the parties that the Leased Equipment is not and shall not become a fixture to the underlying real estate.

4. *Liability of Lessee.* Lessee assumes full responsibility for damage, loss or destruction of the Leased Equipment from the date of delivery until returned to Lessor. Lessee assumes full responsibility for, indemnifies Lessor against, and holds Lessor harmless from, any and all loss, liability, damage and expense in connection with any injury to person or property arising from, or in connection with, the use or operation of the Leased Equipment. If at any time Lessor reasonably believes that the Leased Equipment is about to become damaged or destroyed, it shall have the right to enter and take possession of the Leased Equipment, but shall be under no obligation to do so.

5. *Insurance.* Lessee shall carry and keep in force, at its own expense, public liability insurance and property insurance to protect Lessor in the amount of not less than One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars per accident, and the Leased Equipment shall be insured, and kept insured, at its cost or fair market value for replacement purposes, and the Lessor shall be named as a co-insured party on such policies and be provided with a certificate by Lessee indicating its coverage.

6. *Title and Possession.* The Leased Equipment shall at all times remain and be the sole and exclusive personal property of Lessor, and Lessee shall have only the right to possession and use of the same under the terms of this Lease. It is specifically understood by and between the parties that Lessee shall acquire no equity in, or right of ownership to, the Leased Equipment and shall have no rights of any kind other than those specifically granted herein. Lessee shall no encumber in any way the Leased Equipment or its interest in this Lease or allow any lien or encumbrance to be placed upon the Leased Equipment or its interest in the Lease.

7. *Default.* This Lease may be terminated at the election of the Lessor if Lessee is not maintaining the Leased Equipment, does not comply with the terms or conditions hereof, or otherwise defaults under this Lease. Upon any such default or termination, Lessor may take possession of the Leased Equipment and may relet the same at any rent readily obtainable. Lessee agrees to pay Lessor on demand the amount of all loss and damages (including lost rents and late charges) that Lessor may suffer because of such termination or default, together with all costs Lessor may incur in the collection thereof, including attorneys' fees and court costs.

8. *Assignment.* Lessee may not assign or sublet any of its right, title or interest in and to

this Lease or the Leased Equipment covered hereby without the prior written consent of Lessor. Only Lessee and its employees shall be allowed to use and operate the Leased Equipment during the term of this Lease.

9. *Nonwaiver.* None of the terms, covenants or conditions of this Lease shall be deemed waived by any act of Lessor unless the same is specified in writing.

10. *Severance.* Should any provision of this Lease be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such invalidity, unenforceability or illegality shall not affect the other provisions of this Lease which shall remain in full force and effect.

11. *Amendment and Applicable Law.* This Lease shall be amended only by a writing signed by both parties hereto, and shall be construed under the laws of the State of Tennessee.

12. *Notice of Lease.* Upon the request of either party to the other, both parties shall cooperate and execute the appropriate documents and financing statement(s) (true lease filing(s)) to be filed in the Tennessee Secretary of State's Office to put others on notice that the Leased Equipment is subject to this Lease.

13. *Captions and Binding Effect.* The captions in this Lease are for reference purposes only and shall in no way limit or extend the provisions herein. The Lease shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective successors, assigns and legal representatives.

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## **PREFACE**

Lawrence Countians are vulnerable to a number of different natural and technological hazards.

However, experience and history show that the hazard of Severe Weather has produced all of presidentially-declared and undeclared disasters that have required outside assistance in response and recovery operations.

An Ice Storm in February, 1994 virtually paralyzed Lawrence County for more than a week after electrical power was lost for almost the entire county.

Tornadoes in Iron City (June, 1994) and Ethridge (May, 1995) destroyed many homes and caused injury and loss of life, as most victims were unable to receive advance warnings of the storms.

Lawrence County has also suffered relatively minor damage from flooding and snowstorms, and a economic impact from drought and extreme heat.

Hazard Mitigation has been defined as actions taken to eliminate or reduce the long-term risk to life and property. Therefore, any investment in mitigation programs and activities pays direct dividends following the occurrence of a disaster.

### **Purpose and Scope**

The purpose of the Lawrence County Hazard Mitigation Plan is to identify the major hazards that affect Lawrence County, assess the county's vulnerability to those hazards, and develop strategies to reduce or eliminate those hazards.

Effective mitigation can break the cycle of repeated destruction caused when disasters re-occur.

The scope of this plan will focus on present efforts and future goals in mitigating the natural hazards of severe weather (tornado, severe thunderstorm, winter storm, flooding, drought and extreme heat), fire, earthquake, and the additional hazards of hazardous materials releases and civil disorder.

Lawrence County is also at risk for nuclear attacks, but that hazard will not be addressed in this plan.

## Part I. Hazard Identification

In Lawrence County, there are several different natural and man-made or technological hazards that affect the population.

The hazards, ranked in a descending order of vulnerability risk levels, are as follows:

### 1. SEVERE WEATHER

**a. Tornado**-A tornado is a violently rotating column of air extending downward to the grounds with winds as high as 270 miles per hour. In Lawrence County, tornadoes are a significant hazard and have occurred on a frequent basis. Lawrence County experienced large and destructive tornadoes in Iron City (June 26, 1994) and Ethridge (May 18, 1995), and four other documented less-serious events in May, 1989; June 1991; April, 1994; and September, 1996.

**b. Winter Storms**-Winter storms include ice storms, blizzards, and extreme cold. Winter storms can be especially hazardous due to roads becoming impassable and possible interruption of vital services such as electricity, water, and natural gas. Lawrence County was among the Tennessee Counties that were affected by the most expensive disaster in the state's history, the ICE STORM of February, 1994. The county was virtually paralyzed for a week by the loss of electrical power to almost the entire county.

**c. Severe Thunderstorms**-Lawrence County regularly experiences severe thunderstorms, with the associated occurrence of high winds, lightning, hail and flash flooding. Although not as severe as tornado damage, these storms have damaged and destroyed homes, barns, etc. Vital communications equipment and computer equipment in public offices have been knocked out of service by lightning strikes, and localized flooding has created traffic hazards.

**d. Flooding**-An overabundance of rainfall can present a hazard to Lawrence Countians, but the risk is not considered to be serious. Even the most serious of Floods (Memorial Day Weekend, 1991) have produced only road and street damage, with only a few homes built in flood-prone areas scattered about the county. There are no rivers or streams large enough to pose a serious threat, and Lawrence County's natural drainage systems handle the excess water quite well.

e. **Drought and Extreme Heat-A** drought occurs when a long period of time passes without any substantial rainfall. Extreme heat is defined as temperatures of ten degrees or more above the average high temperature lasting for several weeks.

Lawrence County experiences drought to some extent on an average of every three years, with usually only an increased fire risk until rainfall comes. However, a prolonged drought can have serious economic impact on Lawrence County in both the agricultural and industrial sectors and can indirectly affect the entire population. Agricultural production can be damaged or destroyed by loss of crops or livestock. Widespread drought has also been shown to impact lawn mower sales, resulting in job layoffs at Lawrence County's largest employer, Murray Manufacturing. Lawrence County has been blessed with a plentiful public water supply from Shoal Creek, which has always held up to the most serious droughts, but many wells, ponds, and smaller streams may go dry.

Extreme heat occurs in Lawrence County less frequently than drought, and the immediate risks are to the health of a small number of individuals who are not adequately protected from exposure.

## 2. FIRE, (URBAN FIRE, AND WILDFIRE)

Fires occur in Lawrence County on almost a daily basis, usually affecting a single home or business. However, Lawrence County is at risk for larger-scale "Urban fires", and "Wildfire" in woodland areas.

An urban fire is any instance of uncontrolled burning which results in structural damage to residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and other properties in developed areas. A significant Urban Fire has not yet occurred in Lawrence County, but it could happen, affecting thousands of citizens.

A wildfire is any instance of uncontrolled burning in grasslands, brush, or woodlands. There has been no known experience with a major wildfire in Lawrence County, but one could occur, affecting up to 1,000 people.

## 3. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RELEASE

a. **Hazardous Material Transportation Accident** is any occurrence resulting in the uncontrolled release of materials during transport that are capable of posing risk to health, safety, and property as determined in Department of Transportation Materials Transport Regulations. These materials are generally classified as explosives and blasting agents, flammable and noncombustible gases, combustible liquids, flammable liquids and solids, oxidizers, poisons, etiological agents, radioactive materials, corrosive materials, and other materials including hazardous wastes.



Spills involving petroleum products (Gasoline, diesel fuel) from trucks are the most common hazardous materials release in Lawrence County. Railway accidents, which occur here about every two years, have posed a more serious threat and have necessitated evacuations affecting several hundred residents.

**b. Stationary Hazardous Materials Accident** is any occurrence resulting in the uncontrolled release of materials from a fixed site capable of posing a risk to health, safety, and property as determined in the Environmental Protection Agency Resource Conservation and Recovery Act regulations. Hazardous materials incidents at fixed sites are classed just as they are for transportation accidents. The primary risk in Lawrence County is the accidental release of hazardous materials into Shoal Creek via a stormwater drainage channel that runs through the industrial park. Such a release could threaten Lawrenceburg's water supply, because the water filtration plant is downstream from the channel. Small scale accidental spills occur on a regular basis at Lawrence County's various factories. A large scale accident involving a dangerous material could affect several thousand people.

#### **4. EARTHQUAKE**

An earthquake is the sudden motion or trembling in the earth when caused by an abrupt release of slowly accumulating strain which results in ground-shaking, surface faulting, or ground failures. Although Lawrence County is not considered a high risk area for earthquakes, the population could be affected by a large quake on the New Madrid fault area in West Tennessee, which is predicted to occur by the year 2,040.

#### **5. CIVIL DISORDER**

A civil disorder is defined as any incident intended to disrupt community affairs and threatening the public's safety. Civil disorders include terrorist attacks, riots, strikes resulting in violence, and demonstrations resulting in police intervention and arrests. In Lawrence County, serious civil disorder has not occurred since the 1960's, when state law enforcement assistance was required to protect the population against violence associated with labor unrest at Murray Manufacturing, a large bicycle and lawnmower factory. Although there have been no such serious incidents since, the threat still exists, not only from labor concerns, but also from tensions associated with yearly visits from racist groups to the area. Arson attacks on churches and schools, and bombing of public office buildings are also a threat.

## **Part II. EXISTING MITIGATION EFFORTS & PROPOSED PROJECTS**

There are efforts being made to mitigate hazards in Lawrence County, and more could be accomplished if funds were available. These efforts and goals are outlined addressing the specific hazard areas listed in this plan.

### **I. Severe Weather**

#### **(A). EXISTING MITIGATION EFFORTS**

##### **Tornado, Severe Thunderstorms**

Until recently, Lawrence Countians have been unable to receive severe weather warnings and alerts from the National Weather Service for lack of a NOAA Weather Radio Station to serve the counties in the southern-middle Tennessee area.

The Lawrenceburg/Lawrence County Emergency Management Agency was the lead agency in fundraising and constructing a NOAA Weather Radio Station for the seven counties (Giles, Lawrence, Lewis, Lincoln, Marshall, Maury, and Wayne), which became operational in June, 1996. The entire project cost about \$90,000.

Other Mitigation efforts include public education and awareness regarding severe weather, and additional training and planning regarding the county's volunteer Skywarn Network, which is supported by the Emergency Management Agency.

##### **Flooding**

The City of Lawrenceburg is a member of the National Flood Insurance Program and strictly adheres to a comprehensive ordinance governing construction and drainage. The remaining four cities and Lawrence County have not chosen to participate in the NFIP. Flooding is not a serious hazard in Lawrence County, and the costs associated with adopting county-wide zoning cannot be justified based on the county's history and experience with flood damage.

A "100-year" flood event occurred in Lawrence County on Memorial Day Weekend, 1991. Lawrence County was among eight counties included in a \$4 million disaster declaration, but damage here was limited to \$67,302 in road and street damage county wide, most of it at one location in Lawrenceburg.

The City of Lawrenceburg has noted an increase in storm-water runoff due to the increasing amount of commercial activity on North Locust Avenue. Lawrenceburg hired an engineering firm to formulate a storm water management ordinance (Ordinance #777), which was put into place on February 14, 1992.

Ordinance #777 requires on-site detention facilities to control stormwater runoff and flooding. Detention is a part of all commercial site plans approved by the Lawrenceburg Planning Commission.

The Lawrenceburg Planning Commission feels that a permanent storm water infrastructure (larger, underground storm sewers) may be the future answer to flooding problems, but it will cost millions of dollars. At present, the best most cost-effective answer remains on-site detention until growth and development exceeds the capabilities of the present stormwater drainage system.

#### **Winter Storms**

Winter Storms have had a devastating affect (Ice Storm, February 1994) in Lawrence County, primarily due to the loss of electrical power for an extended period of time.

The Lawrenceburg Power System is presently making improvements in four areas that should lessen the severity of future winter storms: communication, alternate sources, training, and line equipment improvement.

To enhance communications to the public, the power system has installed more outside lines. The answering of these calls during an outage will be handled by a computerized outage reporting system. The staff for dispatching duty has been increased, with training now (November, 1996) ongoing for the new phone system.

At the present time, the entire service area of Lawrenceburg Power is served through one delivery point. During the next three years, four new delivery points will be obtained from TVA. This will greatly reduce the exposure of the system to single point problems and will more than double the number of distribution circuits.

The Ice Storm of 1994 affected many other power systems in the Tennessee Valley area. The Tennessee Valley Public Power Association has printed a valley-wide disaster plan which includes the Lawrenceburg system. There have been two exercises of the plan which Lawrenceburg has participated in to better prepare the staff and serve as a training aid.

The Lawrenceburg Power System is also upgrading service equipment and line protection. Several line trucks have been replaced with more effective and versatile equipment. Also underway is an upgrade of system protective devices to minimize the area affected by damaged equipment.

#### **Drought and Extreme Heat**

The most serious affects of widespread (nation- or world-wide) Drought and Extreme Heat has been the loss of jobs due to depressed lawn mower sales at the Lawrence County's largest employer. Locally, Lawrence County has not had the typical problems with elderly and other economically-disadvantaged individuals who may be exposed to Extreme Heat conditions. Lawrence County has always enjoyed a plentiful water supply even during the worst of drought conditions.

Unless that experience changes, this plan will offer no policies or projects to mitigate the affects of drought and extreme heat.

### **(B). PROPOSED MITIGATION PROJECTS**

Advanced warning and preparedness is the key to mitigating the danger of tornadoes and severe weather. In order to accomplish these mitigation goals, Lawrence County would undertake the following projects if funds were available.

#### **#1-PROMOTION OF NOAA WEATHER RADIO SYSTEM**

A series of Newspaper and Radio Advertisements could be done for approximately \$3,500, to educate the public about the capabilities of the new NOAA Weather Radio system.

#### **#2-COUNTY-WIDE SIREN WARNING SYSTEM**

Lawrence County would greatly benefit from a system of directional and omni-directional sirens to warn the populace about incoming tornadoes, which have been recorded in the county five times since 1989.

Lawrence County could be covered adequately by 20 sirens, one at the county fire stations at Center Point, Crossroads, Ethridge, Gandy, Henryville, Iron City, Leoma, New Prospect, Southeast, St. Joseph, Summertown, West End, and West Point; three in Lawrenceburg; two in Loretto, and two others in populated fringe areas not served by a local fire hall. The cost of this siren system would be \$350,000.

#### **#3-COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FOR SKYWARN NETWORK**

The local amateur radio network is in need of improved communications equipment, including a high-power, centrally-located transmitter with auxiliary receivers in strategic locations around the county. Due to terrain conditions, present equipment cannot reach certain areas of the county, and spotters are unable to transmit vital information back to the Emergency Operations Center and National Weather Service. This equipment could be obtained for about \$10,000, and would also be beneficial during response and recovery operations.

#### **#4-POWER SYSTEM COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT IMPROVEMENTS**

The Lawrenceburg Power System is in need of a better communications with their trucks. A new system utilizing two repeater stations and a paging system is needed to enable the central office to communicate with their crews out in remote county areas, costing an estimated \$40,000.

**TOTAL MITIGATION COSTS (SEVERE WEATHER) \$403,500**

**Lead Agencies: Local EMA (Warning and communications projects); Power System (Protection of Utilities.)**

## II. FIRE, (URBAN FIRE, AND WILDFIRE)

### **(A). EXISTING MITIGATION EFFORTS**

The City of Lawrenceburg has the only paid, professional firefighting department in the county, while the rest are served by volunteers at 15 stations at communities throughout Lawrence County. Equipment and training varies from station to station, but generally, Lawrence Countians are served quite well for the amount of tax dollars and donated funds to operate these volunteer departments.

A recent reorganization of the volunteer fire services appears to improving coordination among the departments. Improvements are underway in the communication system, and a current project with Emergency Management is being studied to establish a centralized depot to stock equipment to facilitate search and rescue, and hazardous materials response.

### **(B). PROPOSED MITIGATION PROJECTS**

#### **#1-FIRE HYDRANTS FOR RURAL WATER UTILITY LINES**

Firefighting in various areas of the county are hampered due to lack of fire hydrants on available water lines. This is particular frustrating in areas that have received new 6-inch water line extensions with the federal grant funds.

Under the present system, rural utility systems are discouraged from adding fire protection in their projects when applying for grants, and local utility districts have been unable to afford the installation of fire hydrants on new line extensions.

Lawrence Countians would benefit from the addition of 100 fire hydrants in areas with available six inch water lines, at a cost of \$1,400 each, for a total of \$140,000. This could not only help lower insurance rates for residents, but assist local volunteer departments in containing fires that could expand into a wildfire or threaten entire neighborhoods in rural areas.

### III. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RELEASE

#### **(A). EXISTING MITIGATION EFFORTS**

The Lawrenceburg Fire Department currently has eight firemen with hazardous materials technician level certification or higher. Through mutual aid agreements, these paid professionals have been and will continue to be available to respond to hazardous materials incidents within Lawrence County.

Obtaining the necessary equipment and training to deal with hazardous materials incidents in an ongoing process, and the departments have performed well in both transportation and stationary accidental releases of hazardous materials.

#### **(B) PROPOSED MITIGATION PROJECTS**

##### **1. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE TRAILER**

The Haz-Mat team is in need of an equipment trailer and some additional supplies and equipment to respond to releases in Lawrence County. This could be accomplished for **\$30,000**.

##### **2. NEW CHLORINE ROOM AT WATER FILTER PLANT**

The City of Lawrenceburg's Water Filtration Plant presents a chlorine hazard to workers and nearby residents if a release occurred. The chlorine cylinders should be housed in a separate building, equipped with containment measures in case of a major leak. Total costs are estimated at **\$125,000**.

##### **3. TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT FOR VOLUNTEERS**

Volunteer firefighters need specialized training and more equipment to expand hazard-material response capabilities. An investment of **\$50,000** into the Hazmat/Search & Rescue Station project would provide needed equipment so that efforts could be focused on training.

**TOTAL MITIGATION COSTS (Hazardous Materials) \$185,000**

**Lead Agencies: Lawrenceburg Fire Department; Lawrence County Fire & Rescue, Inc; Local Emergency Planning Committee.**

#### IV. EARTHQUAKE

##### **(A). EXISTING MITIGATION EFFORTS**

Lawrence County is not believed to be at risk for a damaging earthquake, but could experience some damage from a large quake in the New Madrid seismic zone.

Other than public education and adherence to local building codes, the main focus of Earthquake Mitigation has been participation in exercises and planning for commitment of resources to an earthquake stricken area for response and urban search and rescue.

##### **(B) PROPOSED MITIGATION PROJECTS**

###### **1. PROTECTION OF VITAL COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT**

Inexpensive cords and straps could be used to secure vital radio transmission equipment to prevent them from tipping over during an earthquake. This could be accomplished county-wide for about \$500.

###### **2. INSPECTING PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND CORRECTING HAZARDS**

Schools, libraries, and other public buildings should be inspected for earthquake hazards like falling bookshelves, etc., and deficiencies should be corrected with appropriate hardware. This could be accomplished for \$2,500.

**Lead Agencies: Lawrenceburg City and Lawrence County  
Codes Enforcement**

## 5. CIVIL DISORDER

### **(A). EXISTING MITIGATION EFFORTS**

Certain events have brought about occurrences of Civil Disorder in Lawrence County. A labor strike at Murray Manufacturing in the early 1960's eventually had to be quelled by outside law enforcement agencies called in by the Governor's office.

Lawrence County has hosted rallies and marches by the Ku Klux Klan, Skinheads, Aryan Nations, and other white supremacist groups have chosen nearby Pulaski as their birthplace.

Lawrenceburg Police have been actively training and obtaining surplus military equipment for a newly established SWAT (Special Weapons and Tactics) Team.

Both Lawrenceburg Police and County Sheriff's officers are being provided information concerning Militia activity, church arsons, and terrorist bombing activity that have been occurring in the United States in recent history.

While Civil Disorder and the above related activities are not considered to be a threat on a daily basis, law enforcement agencies are working to be prepared should they occur.

### **(B) PROPOSED MITIGATION PROJECTS**

#### **1. MOBILE COMMAND/COMMUNICATIONS POST**

Lawrence County does not have a mobile command post capable of supporting emergency operations. This vehicle would not only aid law enforcement, but would be valuable in the event of large-scale fires, tornadoes, and other events requiring an extended presence in a stricken area. The local Emergency Management Agency has made this a priority project following the completion of the NOAA Weather Radio Station Project. Estimated cost of a suitable vehicle to meet Lawrence County needs is \$80,000, which would be for a \$40,000 motor home, and \$40,000 in equipment.

**TOTAL MITIGATION COSTS (CIVIL DISORDER) \$80,000**
