

RESOLUTION TO ASK BUDGET COMMITTEE TO ADJUST BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1997-1998 SO THAT PROPERTY TAX RATE CAN BE REDUCED

WHEREAS, the County Executive and the County Legislative body of Lawrence County desire tax relief for the property owners of Lawrence County, Tennessee;

WHEREAS, Lawrence County has received a lower interest rate than expected on the recent bond issue, and;

WHEREAS, sales tax collection for the past year are greater than anticipated, and;

WHEREAS, the expenditures for operations of a solid waste facility are expected to cease July 1, 1997 under the new management of the Lawrence County Solid Waste Authority.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County Executive and County Legislative body of Lawrence County express their commitment of the aforementioned excess funds to the 1997-1998 budget so as to reduce the tax levy from \$3.16 to a rate not to exceed \$2.89 for the fiscal year 1997-1998.

This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND THE COUNTY COURT CLERK TO BORROW FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE ON ALEXANDER SPRINGS ROAD ACROSS BUFFALO CREEK AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE ON HARDIN LOOP ROAD ACROSS FACTORY CREEK

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee has determined that it is necessary and desirable to construct two bridges (the "Project") for the benefit of the citizens of the Local Government; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that the Project will promote or provide a traditional governmental activity or otherwise fulfill a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Parts I, IV, and VI of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Act"), local governments in Tennessee are authorized to finance the cost of this Project through the issuance and sale of interest bearing capital outlay notes upon the approval of the State Director of Local Finance; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that it is advantageous to the Local Government to authorize the issuance of capital outlay notes to finance the cost of the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. That, for the purpose of providing funds to finance the cost of the Project in and for the Local Government, the County Executive of the Local Government is hereby authorized in accordance with the terms of this resolution to issue and sell interest-bearing capital outlay notes in a principal amount not to exceed ONE HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND AND ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$110,100.00) (the "Notes") at either a competitive public sale or at a private negotiated sale upon approval of the State Director of Local Finance pursuant to the terms, provisions, and conditions permitted by law. The Notes shall be designated "Bridge" Capital Outlay Notes, Series 1997; shall be numbered serially from 1 upwards; shall be dated as of the date of issuance; shall be in denomination(s) as agreed upon the purchaser; shall be sold at not less than 99% of par value and accrued interest; and shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed 6.38 percent (6.38%) per annum, and in no event shall the rate exceed the legal limit provided by law.

Section 2. That, the Notes shall mature not later than three (3) years after the date of issuance and that the Notes and any extension or renewal notes shall not exceed the reasonably expected economic life of the Project, which is hereby certified by the Governing Body to be at least three (3) years. Provided, however, that each year the Notes are outstanding, one-third (1/3), but in no event not less than one-ninth (1/9), of the original principal amount of the Notes shall mature without renewal but subject to prior redemption.

Section 3. That, the Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the Local Government, in whole or in part, at any time, at the principal amount and accrued interest to the date of redemption, without a premium, or, if sold at par, with or without a premium of not exceeding one percent (1%) of the principal amount.

Section 4. That, the Notes shall be direct general obligations of the Local Government, for which the punctual payment of the principal and interest on the notes, the full faith and credit of the Local Government is irrevocably pledged and the Local Government hereby pledges its taxing power as to all taxable property in the Local Government for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of principal of and interest on the Notes. The Governing Body of the Local Government hereby authorizes the levy and collection of a special tax on all taxable property of the Local government over and above all other taxes authorized by the Local Government to create a sinking fund to retire the Notes with interest as they mature in an amount necessary for that purpose. (If the revenues generated by the Project are to be applied as additional security for the Notes, described such revenues here.)

Section 5. That, the Notes shall be executed in the name of the Local Government and bear the manual signature of the chief executive officer of the Local Government and the manual signature of the County Clerk with the Local Government seal affixed thereon; and shall be payable as to principal and interest at the office of the Trustee of the Local Government or the paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government. Proceeds of the Notes shall be deposited with the Trustee of the Local Government and shall be paid out for the purpose of financing the Project pursuant to this Resolution and as required by law.

Section 6. That, the Notes will be issued in fully registered form and that at all time during which any Note remains outstanding and unpaid, the Local Government or its agent shall keep or cause to be kept at its office a note register for the registration, exchange or transfer of

the Notes. The note register, if held by an agent of the Local Government, shall at all times be open for inspection by the Local Government or any duly authorized officer of the Local Government. Each Note shall have the qualities and incidents of a negotiable instrument and shall be transferable only upon the note register kept by the Local Government or its agent, by the registered owner of the Note in person or by the registered owner's attorney duly authorized in writing, upon presentation and surrender to the Local Government or its agent together with a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Local Government duly executed by the registered owner or the registered owner's duly authorized attorney. Upon the transfer of any such Note, the Local Government shall issue in the name of the transferee a new registered note or notes of the same aggregate principal amount and maturity as the surrendered Note. The Local Government shall not be obligated to make any such Note Transfer during the fifteen (15) days next preceding an interest payment date on the Notes or, in the case of any redemption of the Notes, during the forty-five (45) days next preceding the date of redemption.

Section 7. That, the Notes shall be in substantially the form attached hereto and shall recite that the Notes are issued pursuant to title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated.

Section 8. That, the Notes shall be sold only after the receipt of the written approval of the State Director of Local Finance for the sale of the Notes.

Section 9. That, the notes are hereby designated as qualified tax-exempt obligations for purpose of Section 265(b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

Section 10. That, after the issuance and sale of the Notes, and for each year that any of the Notes are outstanding, the Local Government shall submit its annual budget to the State Director of Local Finance for approval immediately upon the Local Government's adoption of the budget.

Section 11. That, if any of the Notes shall remain unpaid at the end of three (3) years from the issue date, then the unpaid Notes shall be renewed or extended as permitted by law, or retired from the funds of the Local Government or be converted into bonds pursuant to Chapter 11 of Title 9 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, or any other law, or be otherwise liquidated as approved by the State Director of Local Finance.

Section 12. That, all orders or resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and this Resolution shall become effective immediately

upon its passage.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Lawrence County, Tennessee (the "County"), for value received hereby promises to pay to the registered owner hereof, hereinabove named, in the manner hereinafter provided, the principal amount hereinabove set forth on the dates hereinafter set forth, and to pay interest on the outstanding principal amount hereof at the annual rate of interest hereinabove set forth from the date hereof until the outstanding principal amount of this note is paid. The interest shall be due and payable on November 1, 1997, and semi-annually thereafter on the first day of May and November in each year until this note matures. Principal in the amount of Thirty Six Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$36,700) shall be due and payable annually on May 1, 1998, May 1, 1999, and May 1, 2000. Unless sooner called as hereinafter provided, this Note shall mature and the entire remaining balance together with all accrued interest shall be due and payable in full on May 1, 2000. Both principal hereof and interest hereon are payable in lawful money of the United States of America by check or draft at the office of the County Trustee in Lawrenceburg, Tennessee, as registration agent and paying agent (the "Registration Agent"). The Registration Agent shall make all interest payments with respect to this note on each interest payment date directly to the registered owner hereof shown on the note registration records maintained by the Registration Agent as of the close of business on the fifteenth day of the month next preceding the interest payment date at such owner's address shown on said note registration records, without, except for final payment, the presentation or surrender of this note, and all such payments shall discharge the obligations of the County, to the extent of the payments so made. Payment of principal hereof shall be made upon presentation and surrender of this note to the Registration Agent when due.

This note is subject to redemption without penalty prior to maturity at the option of the County.

This note and the income herefrom are exempt from all state, county, and municipal taxation in the State of Tennessee, except inheritance, transfer and estate taxes and except that such income may not be exempt from Tennessee corporate excise tax and the privilege tax imposed on savings and loan associations.

It is hereby certified, recited, and declared that all acts, conditions and things required to exist, happen and be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this note exist, have happened and have been performed in due time, form and manner as required by law, and that the amount of this note does not exceed any limitation prescribed by the constitution and statutes of the State of Tennessee.
