**CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF LAWRENCE AND
LAWRENCE COUNTY SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY
FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION**

THIS AGREEMENT entered into between the **County of Lawrence** (hereinafter "County") and the **Lawrence County Solid Waste Authority** (hereinafter "Authority").

WHEREAS, the Authority has been established pursuant to Part 9 of the Solid Waste Authority Act of 1991 (TCA 68-211-901 *et seq.*) in order to comply with State law regarding the proper and sanitary disposal of solid waste.

WHEREAS, the Authority operates a landfill, has employees and has the resources necessary for the proper disposal of waste in conformity with State law.

WHEREAS, the County, is a Tennessee County which collects waste through a system of county haulers.

WHEREAS, both the County and Authority desire to promote recycling whenever possible.

WHEREAS, the County wishes to use the service of the Authority, and the Authority wishes to provide its services, on the terms set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants made below, and other and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

I. **SCOPE OF WORK**: Within the county limits of Lawrence County, it is anticipated that solid waste will be transported pursuant to law by the County directly from the places where such solid waste is generated to the landfill site. Once the solid waste is transported to the landfill, the Authority shall service and dispose of the solid waste as required by law. In short, the County will be responsible for the pick up of solid waste, and the Authority will be responsible for the disposal and other service of the waste once it is picked up by the County and delivered to the landfill.

II. **DEFINITIONS**: The following terms shall have these definitions in this Contract.

Residential Customer	Each residential unit with a separate electric service meter.
Commercial Customer	An establishment which is engaged in business operations other than manufacturing. This category includes, but is not limited to, office buildings, restaurants, markets, stores and shopping centers.
Industrial Customer	An establishment which is engaged in manufacturing or other industrial process that is not classified as hazardous or special by the regulations of the state for disposal.

Solid Waste

Waste which has characteristics such as collected and disposed of as part of ordinary municipal garbage collections, including paper, cardboard, plastics, food refuse, and household trash, and specifically, excluding, ash, sludge, tires, bulk waste, construction and demolition waste, industrial waste, defined by applicable state, federal, or local law or regulation, infectious medical wastes, or wastes which are otherwise prohibited by any applicable regulations or policies of federal, state or local entities in the form of raw materials or products.

III. INITIAL RATE; RATE ADJUSTMENTS; COLLECTIONS:

A. INITIAL RATE:

1. Residential Customers: The initial rate for disposal services owed to the Authority by each residential customer shall be THREE DOLLARS AND NO/100 (\$3.00) per month. In addition, each residential customer shall pay each month an administrative fee of FIFTY CENTS (\$ 0.50).
2. Commercial Customers: The initial rate for disposal services owed to the Authority by each commercial customer shall be calculated according to the following schedule:

Commercial Customers with no dumpster:

1 pick up per week*	\$10.00
2 pick ups per week	\$15.00
3 pick ups per week	\$18.00
4 pick ups per week	\$20.00
5 pick ups per week	\$22.00

Pick-ups from a 3 yard dumpster:

1 pick up per week*	\$15.00

Pick-ups from a 4 yard dumpster:

1 pick up per week*	\$15.00

Pick-ups from a 6 yard dumpster:

1 pick up per week*	\$20.00

Pick-ups from an 8 yard dumpster:

1 pick up per week*	\$25.00
2 pick ups per week	\$30.00

*1 pick up is defined as one load of solid waste from dumpster.

3. Industrial Customers: The initial rate for disposal services owed to the Authority by each industrial customer shall be a tipping fee of TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$22.00) per ton of solid waste received at the landfill.

B. REVENUE: Revenue generated by the schedule of fees set forth in III A (1-3) shall be expended only for solid waste management purposes.

C. SURCHARGE: The Authority shall pay the state surcharge which is set in TCA 68-211-835(d).

D. COLLECTION: The County agrees not to collect any waste from a generating entity when that entity is delinquent in any fees owed to the Authority. The due date for the Solid Waste fees, other than the tipping fees for each ton of waste owed by an industrial customer, shall be the 10th day each month. In the event that payment is not received in full on or before the 10th day of each month, then a late penalty in the amount of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per day shall be assessed. In the event that it is necessary to pursue collection, the Authority will be entitled to collect all necessary and reasonable collection costs, including but not limited to attorneys' fees. Any tipping fee owed by an industrial customer is due upon receipt of the solid waste.

E. COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT: The rates which may be charged by the Authority for the second and subsequent years of the contract, including any renewal or extension hereof, shall be adjusted upward or downward annually to reflect changes in the cost of living as reflected by changes in the Consumer Price Index determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics. Upon each anniversary date of this Contract, adjustments will be made upward or downward for 100% of the past year's change in the Consumer Price Index -

Urban Wage Earners compared to the preceding year. In the event that the Bureau of Labor Statistics shall cease to maintain such index during the term of the contract or any extension hereof, the parties agree to base such adjustments upon the governmentally-produced measurement of changes in cost of living most nearly approximating the measurements presently made by the Consumer Price Index.

F. **OTHER ADJUSTMENTS:** Further, the Authority reserves the right to adjust the rates for any other reason upon the majority approval of the Authority and the governing body of the Municipality.

IV. CLOSURE COSTS FOR CURRENT LANDFILL: The County shall pay to the Authority 35% of the total cost necessary to seal and close the current landfill under applicable local, state and federal law and regulations. The City of Lawrenceburg shall pay to the Authority 35% of the total cost necessary to seal and close the current landfill under applicable local, state and federal law and regulations.

V. RECYCLE PROCEDURES: In order to protect the environment, and in order to comply with the 25% solid waste reduction goal and the commands of law, both parties express their sincere and firm commitment to recycling whenever possible. The County will distribute, at the Authority's expense, recycle bags to all residential customers who request them. The County will collect only recyclable solid waste suitable for a Class I landfill on recycle collection routes. The County will refuse to pick up any residential recyclable waste (on recycle routes) not properly bagged in approved recycle bags. Further, the County will make every effort to maintain a "clean and pure" recycle streams. The County will not collect any approved recycle bag from any entity that has used such a bag for a purpose other than for Class I recyclable waste.

VI. INSPECTION: The County reserves the right to inspect the Authority's facilities and records upon reasonable written notice.

VII. COOPERATION: The parties agree to give their full cooperation one with the other to insure that this Contract works as intended for the effective, efficient and legal collection and disposal of solid waste.

VIII. DURATION, TERMINATION AND RENEWAL: This Contract shall remain in full force and effect for a period of three (3) years from and after date hereof; but the parties may terminate it at any time on the terms and conditions unanimously agreed upon and consented to by them. This Contract will automatically renew itself for a like period of three (3) years unless the County provides written notice by Certified Mail of its intent to terminate this Contract to the Chairman of the Authority Board by no later than 90 days before the third anniversary date of this Contract.

IX. TYPES ACCEPTED: The Authority will accept all solid waste presented by the County and delivered to the landfill except hazardous or special waste or any other waste prohibited in a Class I landfill.

X. PRIOR AGREEMENT: It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that no oral agreements or understandings of any kind or character have been entered into, that any previous contracts are hereby voided and superseded by this Contract, and that all agreements between the

parties hereto are contained in this Contract and that this Contract was formed in the State of Tennessee and shall at all times be interpreted under the laws of the State of Tennessee.

XI. **OUT OF COUNTY WASTE:** The County agrees not to collect any waste not generated within the territorial limits of Lawrence County.

XII. **STATE, LOCAL AND FEDERAL LAW:** Both parties agree to operate in compliance with all federal, state and local rules including, but not limited to, obtaining of all applicable permits and licenses.

XIII. **INDEMNIFICATION:** The County will save and hold the Authority harmless from any damage or injury resulting from the County's negligence, intentional acts or breach of this Contract. The Authority will save and hold harmless the County herein from any damage or injury resulting from the Authority's negligence, intentional acts or breach of this Contract.

XVI. **EMPLOYEES:** No employee of the Authority is an employee, agent or representative of the County. Likewise, no employee of the County is an employee, agent or representative of the Authority.

XV. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Contract shall take effect upon its adoption by the governing bodies of all the parties hereto.

WHEREAS, Tennessee's and Lawrence County's citizens are paying the same Medicare tax rate as adjacent states, therefore, our elderly citizens should be reimbursed at the same rate.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Board of Commissioners meeting in special session this 16th day of June, 1997, that this body encourages United States Senators Fred Thompson and Bill Frist and Congressman Van Hilleary to initiate an investigation into medical reimbursements in the State of Tennessee.
