

RESOLUTION TO RAISE THE HOTEL-MOTEL TAX AND APPROVE
DISTRIBUTIONS OF EXTRA REVENUE

WHEREAS, the legislative body of Lawrence County, Tennessee desires to promote tourism in Lawrence County; and

WHEREAS, the hotel-motel tax has been used in the promotion of such tourism; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 1993 this legislative body established a privilege tax upon the privilege of occupancy in any hotel at a rate of two (2%) percent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative body of Lawrence County meeting in regular session this 24th day of November, 1998 that the rate of privilege tax upon the privilege of occupancy in any hotel in Lawrence County be raised from two (2%) percent to five (5%) percent, and that subject to said increase in tax generating sufficient proceeds, the proceeds from said increase shall be distributed during the fiscal year 1998-1999 as follows:

1. \$20,000.00 to Lawrence County Chamber of Commerce
2. \$10,000.00 to Lawrenceburg Main Street, Inc.
3. \$15,000.00 to used at the discretion of the Lawrence County Commission Economic Development Committee and the Lawrence County Commission Tourism Committee, making joint decisions for promotion of tourism in Lawrence County

Should said increase in tax not generate sufficient proceeds for the above distribution, then each agency shall receive a pro rata distribution. Should said increase in tax generate more than the proposed proceeds, the balance of said tax shall be paid into the general fund. The increase in the privilege tax shall become effective on January 1, 1999.

District 5

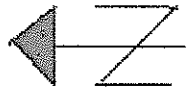

District 6

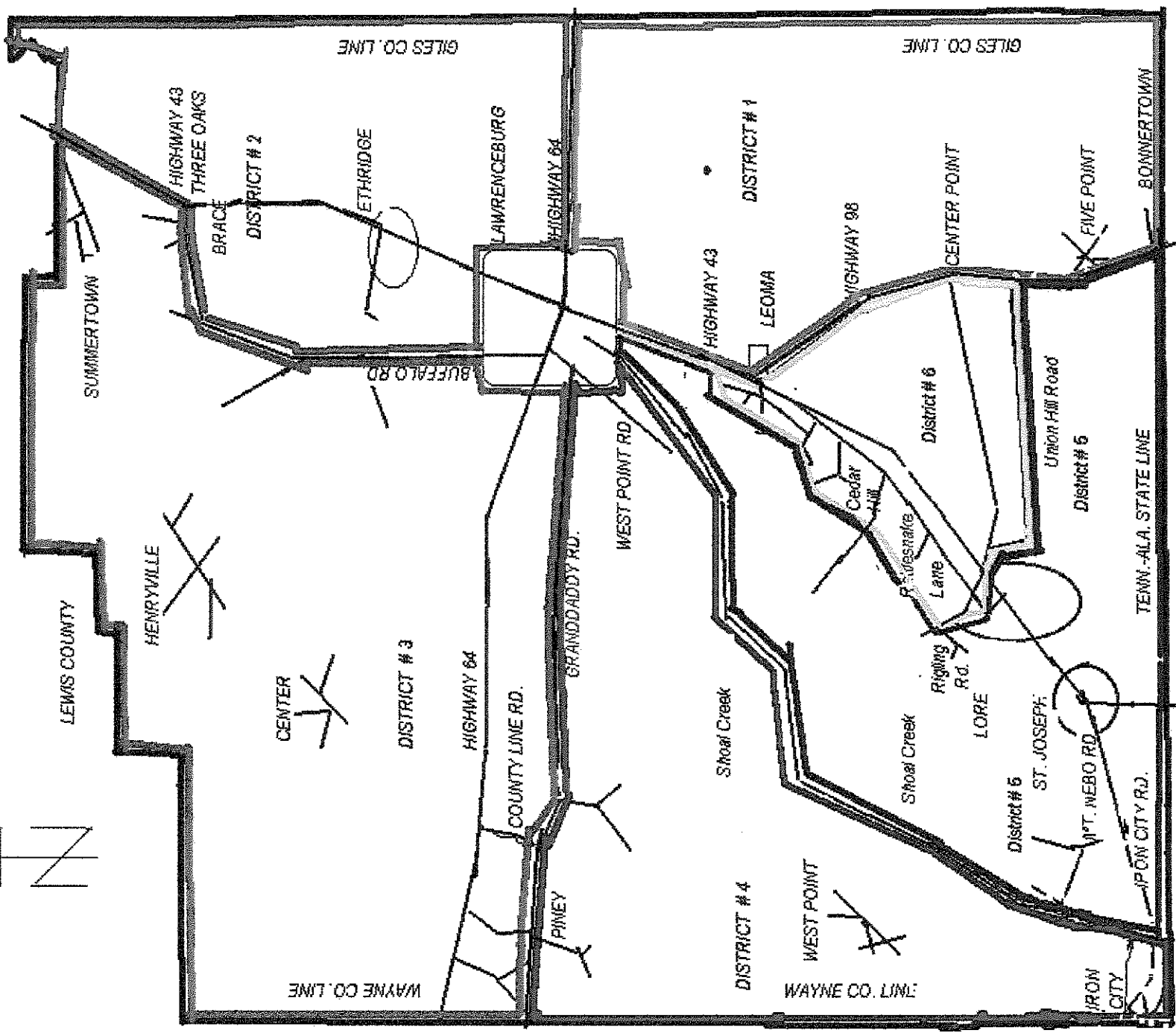



WHEREAS, Tennessee law presently allows the State Legislature to modify county boundary lines without the consent of the county legislative bodies or the county residents of the county; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Legislative Body of Obion County, and hopefully the desire of all county legislative bodies in Tennessee, that a county commission have a statutory right to take part in any decision regarding its county boundary lines; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Legislative Body of Lawrence County to support the County Legislative Body of Obion County in requesting that Tennessee Code §5-2-104 be amended to include the county commission in having a statutory right to take part in any decision regarding its county boundary lines.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislative Body of Lawrence County, meeting this 24th day of November, 1998, that:

1. It is the desire of the County Legislative Body of Lawrence County that Tennessee Code Annotated §5-2-104 be amended to read as follows:
5-2-104. Boundary changes-plats and surveys. - (a) All applications for legislation changing county lines shall be accompanied by an accurate survey and plat, showing the changes asked for, and giving courses and distances of the county line as it will be left after such change should be made.
(b) No bill providing for such change shall be in order unless first approved by two thirds (2/3) or more of the county commissioners of all counties affected by such boundary line change.
2. A copy of this Resolution shall be immediately forwarded to Senator Pete Springer and Representative Jon White and it is requested that each of them support this bill as submitted to the Senate and House of Representatives in the next legislative session.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall also be sent to all county executives in Tennessee in the desire that they will contact their State legislators and encourage the passage of this amendment to Tennessee Code §5-2-104.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to each member of the Lawrence County Commission and shall be recorded upon the minutes of this meeting by the County Clerk.

RESOLUTION FOR FLOOD INSURANCE

WHEREAS, certain areas of Lawrence County, Tennessee, are subject to periodic flooding, mudslides, (i.e., medflies), or flood-related erosion, causing serious damages to properties within these areas; and

WHEREAS, relief is available in the form of Federally subsidized flood insurance as authorized by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Board of Community Commissioners of Lawrence County, to require the recognition and evaluation of flood, mudslide (i.e., mudflow), or flood-related erosion hazards in all official actions relating to land use in areas having these hazards; and

WHEREAS, the body has the legal authority to adopt land use and control measures to reduce future flood losses pursuant to Sections 13-7-101 through 13-7-115, Tennessee Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Lawrence County, hereby:

1. Assures the Federal Insurance Administration that it will enact as necessary, and maintain in force in these areas having flood, mudslide (i.e., mudflow), or flood-related erosion hazards, adequate land use and control measures with effective enforcement provisions consistent with the Criteria set forth in Section 1910, of the National Flood Insurance Program Regulations; and
2. Vests County Executive with the responsibility, authority, and means to:
 - a. Assist the Administrator, at his request, in his delineation of the limits of the area having special flood, mudslide (i.e., mudflow), or flood-related erosion hazards.
 - b. Provide such information as the Administrator may request concerning present uses and occupancy of the floodplain mudslide (i.e., mudflow) or flood-related erosion areas.
 - c. Cooperate with Federal, State, and local agencies and private firms which undertake to study, survey, map, and identify floodplain, mudslide (i.e., mudflow), or flood-related erosion areas, and cooperate with neighboring communities with respect to management of adjoining floodplain, mudslide (i.e., mudflow) and/or flood-related erosion areas in order to prevent aggravation of existing hazards.
 - d. Submit on the anniversary date of the community's initial eligibility an annual report to the Administrator on the progress made during the past year within the community in the development and implementation of floodplain management measures.

- e. Upon occurrence, notify the Administrator in writing whenever the boundaries of the community have been modified by annexation or the community has otherwise assumed or no longer has authority to adopt and enforce floodplain management regulations for a particular area. In order that all Flood Hazard Boundary Maps and Flood Insurance Rate Maps accurately represent the community's boundaries, include within such notification a copy of a map of the community suitable for reproduction, clearly delineating the new corporate limits or new area for which the community has assumed or relinquished floodplain management regulatory authority.
3. Appoints County Executive to maintain for public inspection and to furnish upon request, for the determination of applicable flood insurance risk premium rates within all areas having special flood hazards identified on a Flood Hazard Boundary Map or Flood Insurance Rate Map, any certificates of floodproofing, and information on the elevation (in relation to mean-sea-level) of the level of the lowest habitable floor (including basement if habitable) of all new or substantially improved structures, and include whether or not such structures contain a basement, and if the structure has been floodproofed the elevation (in relation to mean-sea-level) to which the structure was floodproofed;
4. Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the program.


This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption and approval, the public welfare requiring it.
