



**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENACT  
LEGISLATION ALLOWING PRAYER IN SCHOOLS**

**WHEREAS**, the call for separation of church and state evokes fear for religious freedom;  
and

**WHEREAS**, the law is to give freedom of that faith in God, not freedom from God; and

**WHEREAS**, the founders of the American dream knew that the highest ideals of the  
American system reflected the Bible-based Judeo-Christian heritage of our citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, it was not unusual for our forefathers to interrupt their deliberations and call  
upon Almighty God for strength and guidance; and





**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE, SALE AND PAYMENT OF INTEREST-BEARING TWO YEAR CAPITAL OUTLAY NOTE NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING PROPERTY ON BICENTENNIAL BLVD. IN LAWRENCEBURG**

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of Lawrence County, Tennessee has determined that it is necessary and desirable to purchase certain property on Bicentennial Blvd., in Lawrenceburg (the "Project") for the benefit of the citizens of the Local Government; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body has determined that the Project will promote or provide a traditional governmental activity or otherwise fulfill a public purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of Parts I, IV, and VI of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Act"), local governments in Tennessee are authorized to finance the cost of this Project through the issuance and sale of interest bearing capital outlay notes upon the approval of the State Director of Local Finance; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body finds that it is advantageous to the Local Government to authorize the issuance of capital outlay notes to finance the cost of the project;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. That, for the purpose of providing funds to finance the cost of the Project in and for the Local Government, the legislative body of the Local Government is hereby authorized in accordance with the terms of this resolution to issue and sell interest-bearing capital outlay notes in a principal amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) (the "Notes") at either a competitive public sale or at a private negotiated sale upon approval of the State Director of Local Finance pursuant to the terms, provisions, and conditions permitted by law. The Notes shall be designated "Lawrence County Real Estate Purchase Capital Outlay Notes, Series 1999" shall be numbered serially from 1 upwards; shall be dated as of the date of issuance; shall be in denomination(s) as agreed upon with the purchaser; shall be sold at not less than 99% of par value and accrued interest; and shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed four percent (4%) per annum, and in no event shall the rate exceed the legal limit provided by law.

Section 2. That, the Notes shall mature not later than two (2) years after the date of issuance and that the Notes and any extension or renewal notes shall not exceed the reasonably expected economic life of the Project, which is hereby certified by the Governing Body to be at least 2 years. Provided, however, that each year that Notes are outstanding, one-ninth (1/9), but in no event not less than one-ninth (1/9), of the original principal amount of the Notes shall mature without renewal but subject to prior redemption.

Section 3. That, the Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the Local Government, in whole or in part, at any time, at the principal amount and accrued interest to the date of redemption, without a premium, or, if sold at par, with or without a premium of not exceeding one percent (1%) of the principal amount.

Section 4. That, the Notes shall be direct general obligations of the Local Government, for which the punctual payment of the principal and interest on the notes, the full faith and credit of the Local Government is irrevocably pledged and the Local Government hereby pledges its taxing power as to all taxable property in the Local Government for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of principal of and interest on the Notes. The Governing Body of the Local Government hereby authorizes the levy and collection of a special tax on all taxable property of the local government over and above all other taxes authorized by the Local Government to create a sinking fund to retire the Notes with interest as they mature in an amount necessary for that purpose.

The Notes shall be further secured by the real estate being purchased. (If the revenues generated by the Project are to be applied as additional security for the Notes, describe such revenues here.)

Section 5. That, the Notes shall be executed in the name of the Local Government and bear the manual signature of the chief executive officer of the Local Government and the manual signature of the Trustee with the Local Government seal affixed thereon; and shall be payable as to principal and interest at the office of the Trustee of the Local Government or the paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government. Proceeds of the Notes shall be deposited with the Trustee of the Local Government and shall be paid out for the purpose of financing the Project pursuant to this Resolution and as required by Law.

Section 6. That, the Notes will be issued in fully registered form and that at all times during which any Note remains outstanding and unpaid, the Local Government or its agent shall

keep or cause to be kept at its office a note register for the registration, exchange or transfer of the Notes. The note register, if held by an agent of the Local Government, shall at all times be open for inspection by the Local Government or any duly authorized officer of the Local Government. Each Note shall have the qualities and incidents of a negotiable instrument and shall be transferable only upon the note register kept by the Local Government or its agent, by the registered owner of the Note in person or by the registered owner's attorney duly authorized in writing, upon presentation and surrender to the Local Government or its agent together with a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Local Government duly executed by the registered owner or the registered owner's duly authorized attorney. Upon the transfer of any such Note, the Local Government shall issue in the name of the transferee a new registered note or notes of the same aggregate principal amount and maturity as the surrendered Note. The Local Government shall not be obligated to make any such Note transfer during the fifteen (15) days next preceding an interest payment date on the Notes or, in the case of any redemption of the Notes, during the forty-five (45) days next preceding the date of redemption.

Section 7. That, the Notes shall be in substantially the form attached hereto and shall recite that the Notes are issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated.

Section 8. That, the Notes shall be sold only after the receipt of the written approval of the State Director of Local Finance for the sale of the Notes.

Section 9. That, the Notes are hereby designated as qualified tax-exempt obligations for purpose of Section 265(b)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

Section 10. That, after the issuance and sale of the Notes, and for each year that any of the Notes are outstanding, the Local Government shall submit its annual budget to the State Director of Local Finance for approval immediately upon the Local Government's adoption of the budget.

Section 11. That, if any of the Notes shall remain unpaid at the end of two (2) year from the issuance date, then the unpaid Notes shall be renewed or extended as permitted by law, or retired from the funds of the Local Government or be converted into bonds pursuant to Chapter 11 of Title 9 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, or any other law, or be otherwise liquidated as approved by the State Director of Local Finance.

Section 12. That, all orders or resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and this Resolution shall become effective immediately

upon its passage.



**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE UTILITIES COMMITTEE AND COUNTY EXECUTIVE STEVE HILL TO MAKE A PROPOSAL TO THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG FOR ALLOCATING LANDFILL ASSETS AND LIABILITIES BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND CITY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lawrenceburg and Lawrence County entered into an Interlocal Agreement in 1986 for the operation of a landfill for solid waste disposal for the benefit of all persons within Lawrence County; and

**WHEREAS**, such partnership was funded by both city and county; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lawrenceburg no longer is an active participant in the operation of the landfill; and

**WHEREAS**, there are certain issues to be resolved regarding the assets and liabilities to be allocated between the city and county which originated from the previous partnership.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the legislative body of Lawrence County meeting in regular session this 25th day of May, 1999 authorizes the Utilities Committee and County Executive Hill to make the following proposal to the City of Lawrenceburg to allocate landfill assets and liabilities between the City of Lawrenceburg and Lawrence County:

1. The City of Lawrenceburg will assume fifty (50%) percent of postclosure liability for toxic cleanup if any.
2. The City of Lawrenceburg will provide forty (40) acres of land to provide fill dirt for the landfill (title to land to remain in the City), and the City will provide a portion of the transportation, to be agreed upon, of dirt to the landfill in exchange for the previous agreement to provide a forty (40) acre tract of land to the County as set out in the 1998 amendment to their Interlocal Agreement.
3. The City of Lawrenceburg will relinquish all title or claims to the property and other assets at the landfill location and any amounts that the City of Lawrenceburg owed to the authority or to the County be forgiven.
4. The County will assume closure costs of the landfill (through the disposal fees).
5. The County will be responsible for postclosure costs except for fifty (50%) percent of post-closure liability.

This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption and approval.
