





associated with such membership and prior service under said act is required; now, therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative body of Lawrence County meeting in regular session this 23rd day of May, 2000, hereby agrees to pay for the cost of an actuarial study associated with membership and prior service pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §8-35-226.

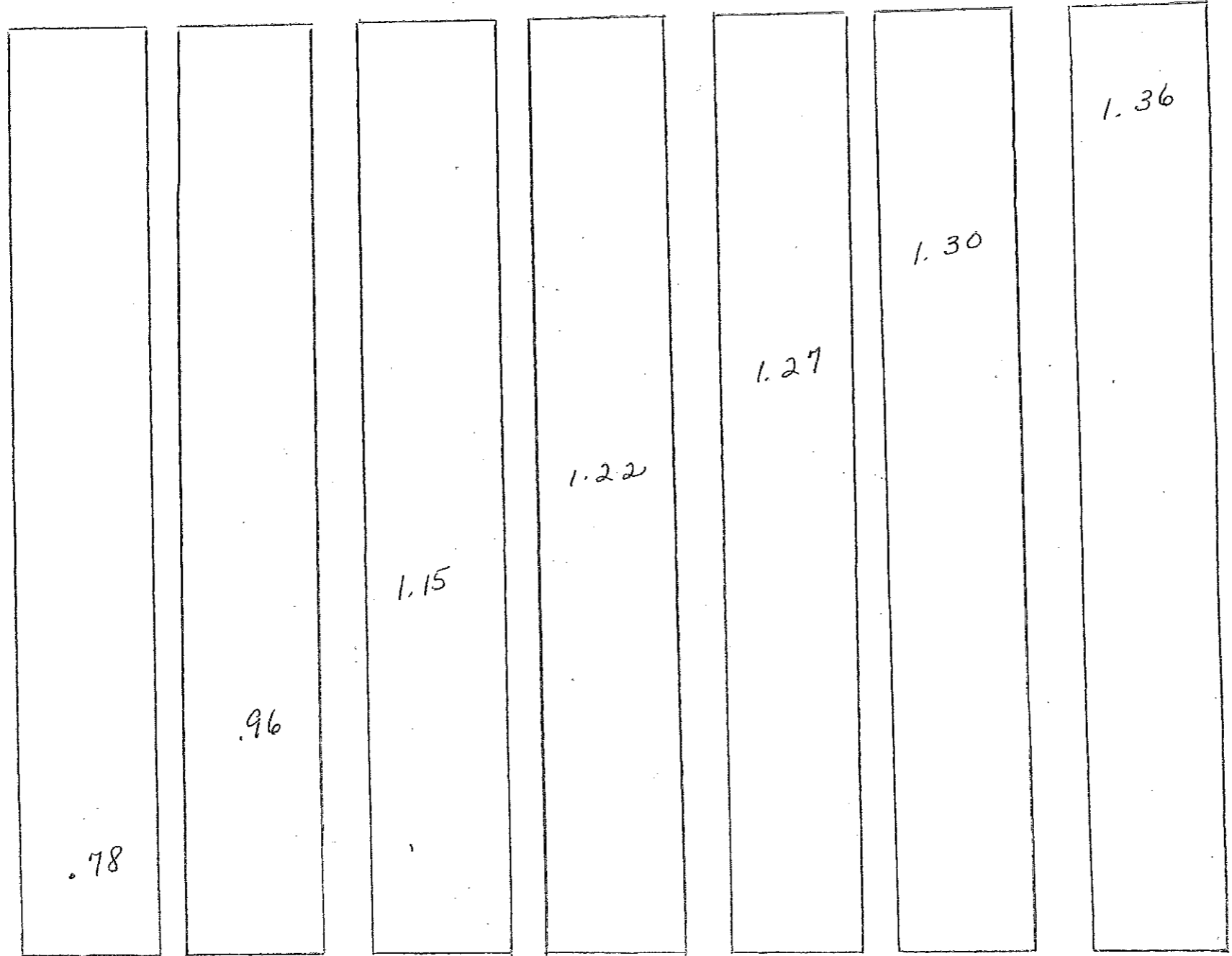

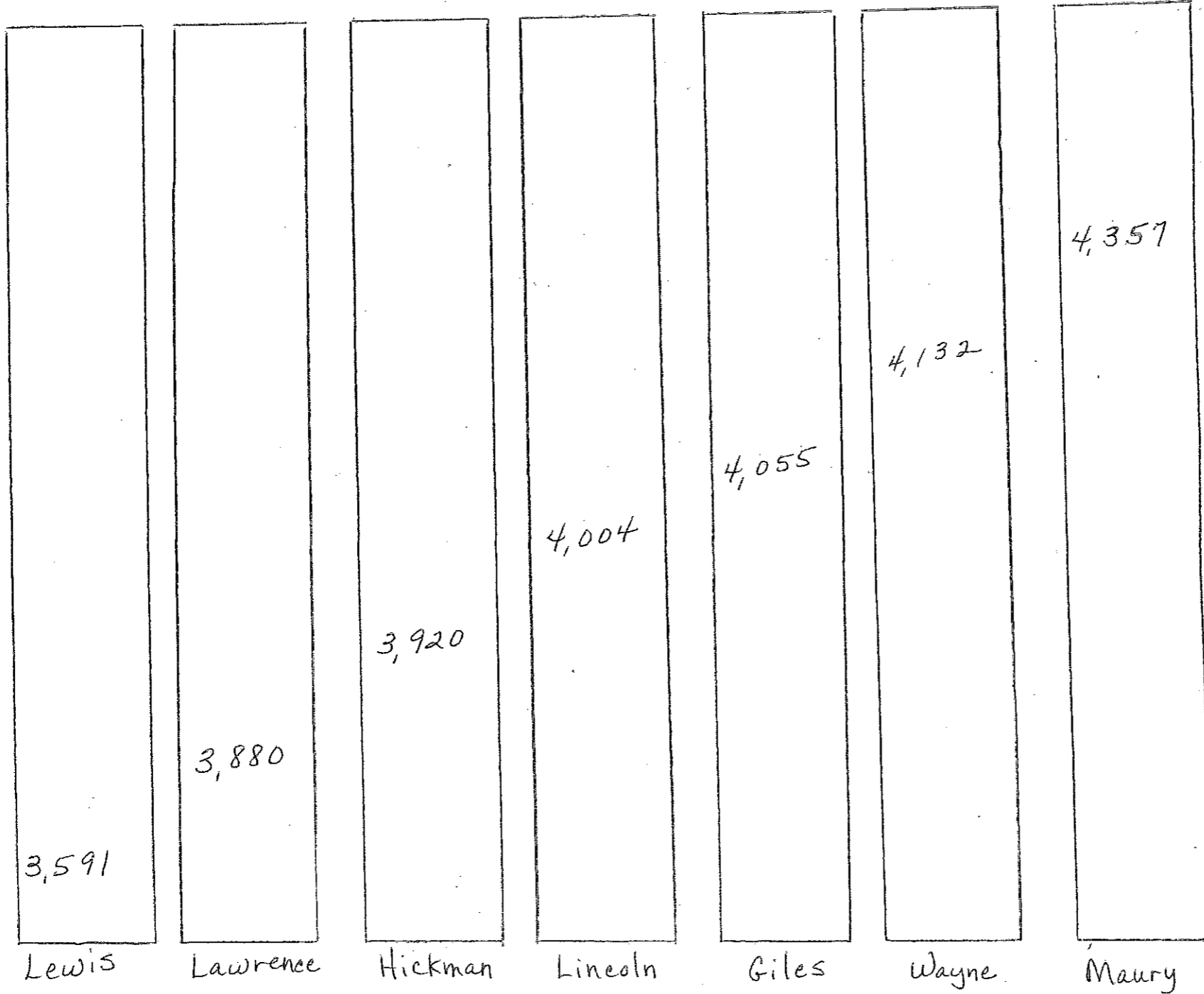


Expenditures per Pupil in Average Daily Attendance
