

BEFORE THE GENERAL SESSIONS COURT AND THE JUVENILE COURT OF
LAWRENCE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the legislative body of Lawrence County is interested in implementing a mediation program between victims and offenders; and

WHEREAS, funds are needed in order to implement such program and the Tennessee State Legislature has authorized counties to levy a litigation tax for this purpose.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative body of Lawrence County meeting in regular session this 28th day of November, 2000 that a \$1.00 tax on litigation shall be collected on all cases and matters before the General Sessions Court and the Juvenile Court of Lawrence County. Such tax shall be taxed as part of the costs of the cause, and in no case shall be omitted. The tax collected by the clerk of the court shall be placed in a separate and segregated fund for victim-offender mediation and shall be used exclusively to support victim-offender mediation in Lawrence County. Agencies or individuals to whom cases are referred by the General Sessions and Juvenile Courts of Lawrence County to conduct mediation shall submit detailed descriptions of mediation services rendered in court referred cases, for payment to the clerk of the court who will, after approval by the appropriate court, pay for such services from the Victim-Offender Mediation Fund.

This resolution shall take effect January 1, 2001, the general welfare requiring it.

TO URGE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO ENACT
LEGISLATION TO AUTHORIZE A LOCAL-OPTION
REALTY TRANSFER TAX.

WHEREAS, many counties in the State of Tennessee are struggling to find sufficient revenue sources in order to meet the growing demands of their citizens for services which are vital and fundamental to the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of this state, to provide improvements to infrastructure required by population and economic growth, and to meet state mandates such as those required by the Basic Education Program; and,

WHEREAS, meeting the demands for capital improvements required by the standards and mandates of the Basic Education Program has been especially burdensome on the financial resources of county governments for that last few years, with a record amount of debt being incurred for school construction and renovation; and

WHEREAS, county governments are limited by state law regarding the forms of taxation and revenue generation which the county is authorized to use, leaving many counties overly dependant on the property tax as a primary source of revenue; and

WHEREAS, proposed legislation to authorize counties to levy a local option transfer tax would provide a desperately needed additional revenue source for counties by authorizing county legislative bodies to levy, by a resolution adopted by a 2/3 vote at two consecutive regular meetings, a tax on the privilege of recording instruments that transfer interests in real property in the office of the register of deeds in the same manner and amount as the state transfer tax; and

WHEREAS, this proposed legislation would be permissive and would not levy a tax, but merely authorize counties to levy a transfer tax if the county legislative body finds it is in the best interest of the county to do so;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of _____ County, meeting in _____ session on this _____ day of _____, 2000, that the Tennessee General Assembly is strongly urged to pass the proposed local option transfer tax legislation, in order to provide needed fiscal relief to county governments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the county clerk shall mail certified copies of this resolution to the members of the Tennessee General Assembly representing the people of _____ County.
