



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF INTEREST BEARING GENERAL OBLIGATION CAPITAL OUTLAY NOTES, SERIES 2001, IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS (\$400,170) OF LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE ISSUANCE, SALE AND PAYMENT OF SAID NOTES; ESTABLISHING THE TERMS THEREOF AND THE DISPOSITION OF PROCEEDS THEREFROM; AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF TAX FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE NOTES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Lawrence County, Tennessee (the "County") has determined that it is necessary and desirable to finance the costs of highway department equipment and construction of a solid waste transfer station, including legal, fiscal, administrative, architectural and engineering costs and including the costs of issuance incident thereto (the "Project"); for the benefit of the citizens of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that the Project will promote or provide a traditional governmental activity or otherwise fulfill a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Sections 9-21-601 to 9-21-607, inclusive, Tennessee Code Annotated, (the "Act") subject to the approval of the State Director of Local Finance, counties in Tennessee are authorized to finance the cost of the Project through the issuance and sale of interest bearing capital outlay notes; and

WHEREAS, the County finds that it is necessary and advantageous to the County to authorize the issuance and sale of capital outlay notes to finance the cost of the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County, as follows:

Section 1. That, for the purpose of providing funds to finance the cost of the Project, the County Executive is hereby authorized in accordance with the terms of this resolution to issue and sell interest bearing capital outlay notes in the principal amount of not to exceed Four Hundred Thousand One Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$400,170) (the "Notes") at either a competitive public sale or by private negotiated sale upon approval of the State Director of Local Finance pursuant to the

terms, provisions and conditions of the Act. The Notes shall be designated "General Obligation Capital Outlay Notes, Series 2001"; shall be numbered serially from 1 upwards; shall be dated as of the date of issuance; shall be in denomination(s) as agreed upon with the purchaser; shall be sold at not less than ninety-nine percent (99%) of par value and accrued interest; and shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed six percent (6%) per annum, and in no event shall the rate exceed the legal limit provided by law.

Section 2. That, the Notes shall mature not later than three (3) years after the date of issuance and that the Notes and any extension or renewal notes shall not exceed the reasonably expected life of the Project, which is hereby certified by the County to be in excess of three years. Provided, however, that each year the Notes are outstanding, one-third (1/3rd), but in no event not less than one-ninth (1/9th), of the original principal amount of the Notes shall mature without renewal but subject to prior redemption.

Section 3. That, the Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the County, in whole or in part, at any time, at the principal amount thereof and accrued interest to the date of redemption.

Section 4. That, the Notes shall be direct general obligations of the County and the County hereby pledges its taxing power as to all taxable property in the County for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of principal of and interest on the Notes. For the prompt payment of principal of and interest on the Notes, the full faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged. The County hereby authorizes the levy and collection of a special tax on all taxable property of the County over and above all other taxes authorized by the County to create a sinking fund to retire the Notes with interest as they mature in an amount necessary for that purpose.

Section 5. That, the Notes shall be executed in the name of the County and bear the manual signature of the County Executive of the County and the manual signature of the County Clerk with the County's seal affixed thereon; and shall be payable as to principal and interest at the office of the County Executive or the paying agent duly appointed by the County. Proceeds of the Notes shall be deposited with the County Trustee who will establish a construction fund which will be used for the purpose

of constructing the Project pursuant to this Resolution and as required by law.

Section 6. That, the Notes will be issued in fully registered form and that at all times during which any Note remains outstanding and unpaid, the County or its agent shall keep or cause to be kept at its office a note register for the registration, exchange or transfer of the Notes. The Note register, if held by an agent of the County, shall at all times be open for inspection by the County or any duly authorized officer of the County. Each Note shall have the qualities and incidents of a negotiable instrument and shall be transferable only upon the note register kept by the County or its agent, by the registered owner of the Note in person or by the registered owner's attorney duly authorized in writing, upon presentation and surrender to the County or its agent together with a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the County duly executed by the registered owner or the registered owner's duly authorized attorney. Upon transfer of any such Note, the County shall issue in the name of the transferee a new registered note or notes of the same aggregate principal amount and maturity as the surrendered Note. The County shall not be obligated to make any such Note transfer during the fifteen (15) days next preceding an interest payment date on the Notes, during the forty-five (45) days next preceding the date of redemption.

Section 7. That, the Notes shall be in substantially the form attached hereto and shall recite that the Notes are issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated.


Section 8. That, the Notes, shall be sold only after the receipt of the written approval of the State Director of Local Finance for the sale of the Notes.

Section 9. That, after the issuance and sale of the Notes, and for each year that any of the Notes are outstanding, the County shall submit its annual budget to the State Director of Local Finance for approval immediately upon the County's adoption of the budget.

Section 10. That, if any of the Notes shall remain at the end of three (3) years from the issue date, then the unpaid Notes shall be renewed or extended as permitted by law, or retired from the funds of the County or be converted into bonds pursuant to Chapter 21 of Title 9 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, or any other law, or be otherwise liquidated as approved by the State Director of Local Finance.

Section: 11. That, all orders or resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

RESOLUTION NO. 08052201

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE TO REIMBURSE ITSELF FOR CERTAIN EXPENDITURES RELATING TO HIGHWAY/PUBLIC WORKS FUND EXPENDITURES, WITH THE PROCEEDS OF BONDS OR OTHER DEBT OBLIGATIONS TO BE ISSUED BY LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE.

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Commissioners of Lawrence County, Tennessee (the "County") to provide funds to finance the purchase of equipment for the County Highway Department, including legal, fiscal, administrative, architectural and engineering costs incident thereto and to pay costs of issuance incidental thereto (the "Projects"); and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the County to pay all or a portion of the costs associated with said activities by the sale of bonds or other debt obligations of the County; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that it will be necessary to make expenditures in payment of said costs prior to the issuance of said bonds or debt obligations; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to state its intentions with respect to reimbursements for said expenditures in accordance with the requirements of final regulations applicable thereto promulgated by the United States Department of the Treasury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County, as follows:

Section 1. It is reasonably expected that the County will reimburse itself for certain expenditures made by the County in connection with the activities hereinabove described. The County intends to reimburse all such expenditures by issuing its capital outlay notes, bonds or other debt obligations. The expenditures made prior to the issuance of said bonds or other debt obligations are expected to be paid from the General Capital Projects Fund and reimbursement shall be made to the General Capital Projects Fund of the County. Debt service on the bonds or other debt obligations will be paid from a pledge of ad valorem taxes on the County.

Section 2. The maximum principal amount of bonds or other debt obligations expected to be issued to finance the activities hereinabove described is approximately \$400,170.00

Section 3. This resolution shall be placed in the minutes of the County and shall be made available for inspection by the general public at the County Clerk's office.

Section 4. It is the County's reasonable expectation that it will reimburse the original expenditures from the proceeds of bonds or other debt obligations.

Section 5. This resolution constitutes a declaration of official intent under Treas. Reg. 1.150-2.

Section 6. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this resolution shall be in immediate effect from and after its adoption.



WHEREAS, pursuant to T.C.A. §10-7-512, counties that operate or maintain Electronic Mail communications systems are required to adopt a written policy on any monitoring of Electronic Mail communications and the circumstances under which it will be conducted.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lawrence County legislative body meeting in Regular Session this 22nd day of May, 2001, that the attached policy is adopted as Lawrence County's policy on the monitoring of Electronic Mail communications.

Accessing and Using Lawrence County Governments Internet and Electronic Mail Resources

WHAT	Lawrence County supplies corporate Internet and Electronic Mail (e-mail) resources for employees' authorized business purposes while they are at work or traveling on company business. This practice establishes authorization for employee use of Lawrence County Internet and e-mail resources and development of Internet applications and publications.
WHO	All Employees Contract Employees
WHY	Conservation of computing hardware and network resources are essential for Lawrence Counties business operations. Lawrence County wants to ensure that employees maintain high levels of productivity and business efficiency.

HOW

BUSINESS USE OF THE INTERNET

Lawrence County Government supplies Internet hardware, software, and network interconnections for business use for employee communications, computer applications, and workflow automation. Internet services will be allocated to individuals as determined by the County Executive. Employees must follow County Identity guidelines for posting materials and ethical conduct policy.

PERSONAL USE OF THE INTERNET

USE GUIDELINES

The following guidelines are provided to help employees determine the acceptable use of Internet facilities;

PERSONAL USE OF E-MAIL

Because Lawrence Co. Government provides the electronic mail system to assist you in the performance of your job, you should use it for official Lawrence Co. Government business. Incidental and occasional personal use of e-mail is permitted, but these messages will be treated the same as other messages. Lawrence Co. Government reserves the right to access and disclose as necessary all messages sent over its e-mail system, without regard to content. Since you personal messages can be accessed by Lawrence Co. Government management without prior notice, you should not use e-mail to transmit any messages you would not want read by a third party. Worldwide e-mail messages may be sent only with the prior approval from the Lawrence County Executive or his designee. Your e-mail correspondence may be a public record under the public records law and may be subject to inspection under this part.

WAIVER OF PRIVACY

Lawrence County Government has the right, but not the duty, to monitor any and all aspects of its computer system, including, but not limited to monitoring sites employees visit on the internet, reviewing materials downloaded or uploaded by employees, and reviewing e-mail sent and received by employees.

Employees waive any right to privacy in anything they create, store, send or receive on the computer or the internet.

AMENDMENTS

This policy may be amended or revised from time to time. Employees will be provided notice.

ACCEPTABLE USE

- To support Lawrence County work projects and activities.
- To perform research for classes for which Lawrence County provides reimbursements.
- To correspond with instructors and classmates regarding Lawrence County-sponsored school and work assignments.
- To correspond with immediate family members while in travel status.
- Will allow for occasional, short, personal E-mail messages. This is consistent with Lawrence County's policy for personal local telephone calls and is similar with other government agencies.
- E-mail data is considered corporate data and employees should have no expectation of privacy regarding personal messages.

UNACCEPTABLE USE

- To take any actions that willfully cause interference to the network or the work of others.
 - To post items on the Internet that violate laws (including copyright), regulations, or Lawrence County guidelines.
 - To operate a business or solicit employment through the Lawrence County Internet links.
 - To gain any monetary/commercial profit.
 - "Surfing the net", is also prohibited except for county business as well as "Internet Radio".
 - Other unacceptable uses are Internet usage for illegal activities, accessing sexually explicit sites, accessing sites that incur a charge to Lawrence Co. Government, and engaging in activities that violate federal standards of ethical conduct.
 - Internet based screen savers such as Pointcast are prohibited unless approved by Department head or County Executive
- To send mail or other communications, images, files, or programs containing offensive or harassing statements, including comments based on race, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, age, disability, religion or political beliefs
Operating a business, usurping business opportunities or conducting business that conflicts with Lawrence Co. Government business activities.
Sending E-mail messages and using Internet service for personal gain.
For hobbies, entertainment, games, sports, and humor or similar activities.
To initiate or forward electronic chain letters.

DEVELOPMENT OF INTERNET APPLICATIONS AND PUBLICATIONS

The Lawrence County Internet policy is published to address critical issues such as exposure of business sensitive information, consistency in corporate image, maintenance and currentness of material presented on Web pages and access security.

Lawrence County business offices engaged in Internet applications development and publishing shall conform to the provisions of the Lawrence County *Internet Development Procedure*, which contains instructions on Internet development and publishing. The County Executive maintains the procedure. Also, the County Executive maintains and controls the *technical* environment for all Internet development on both the private and public Internet site. This includes access control, security, software, and hardware.

The County Executive is responsible for facilitating *content* issues such as business sensitivity and consistency in corporate image. For all aspects of internal or external Internet development, this office will provide final approval for material that is posted to the public Internet. Violations of this development could

lead to disciplinary actions up to and including termination of employment.

Lawrence County Executives Right to Access Information

The electronic mail system has been installed by Lawrence Co. Government to facilitate business communications. Although each employee has an individual password and computer to access the system, this system belongs to the Lawrence County Government and the contents of e-mail communications are accessible at all times by Lawrence County Government management for any business reason or purpose. These systems may be subject to periodic unannounced inspections, and should be treated like other shared filing systems. All system passwords and encryption keys must be available to Lawrence County Government management, and you passwords or encryption keys must be available to your manager or the County Executive.

Organizational approval for posting material to the Internet is controlled at the County Executive's office and Board of Commissioners Direct Report level. The County Executive will direct the development of Internet procedures that are specific to each organization and delegate responsibility for approval of Web pages as appropriate.

ROLES

County Executive's office/Internet Taskforce Committee

provides and/or develops procedures to assist business units with Web pages. Evaluates emerging technology for appropriate use at Lawrence Counties level and provides technical training and technical support for industry standards. The County Executive provides the technical expertise in operating systems and applications development to assist the business unit in the technical implementation of Internet applications.

The County Executive through administration, shall at his discretion, investigate or assign persons to investigate violations of this written policy.

Department Heads

Department Heads ensure that published information complies with the Lawrence County *Internet Development Procedures* and establishes guidelines for their organizations, if necessary.

Disciplinary Action

An Employee that violates these internet guidelines and procedures may be disciplined up to and including Termination.
