



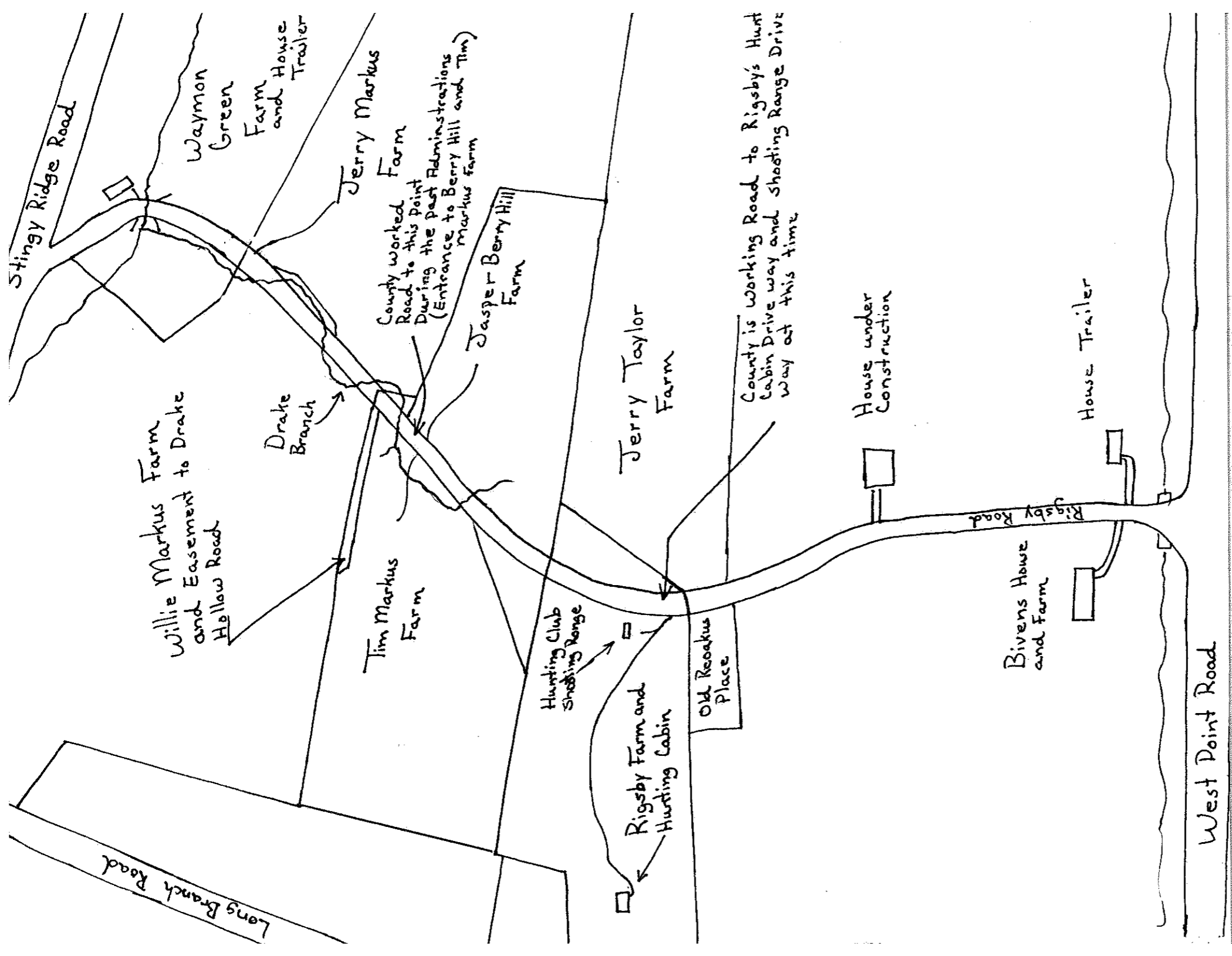

RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE METHOD BY WHICH THE ROADWAYS IN ACTIVE
NON-PROFIT CEMETERIES LOCATED IN LAWRENCE COUNTY
CAN BE ADDED TO THE LAWRENCE COUNTY ROAD LIST

WHEREAS, there are numerous active non-profit cemeteries located in Lawrence County; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Lawrence County that said cemeteries have sufficient roadways to travel for funerals, etc.; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Highway Department is prohibited from working on roadways that are not on the county road list.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lawrence County legislative body meeting in regular session this 23rd day of July, 2002, that:

1. There is hereby created a special classification to the county road list to be known as Cemetery Roads, which classification shall be subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.
2. Any active, public, non-profit cemetery located in Lawrence County may dedicate the roadways in said cemetery to Lawrence County for inclusion on the county road list under the classification of Cemetery Roads subject to the acceptance of said roadway by the Lawrence County legislative body;
3. Before such cemetery roadway shall be accepted by the Lawrence County legislative body, the roadway shall be inspected by the county legislative body Highway Committee and the Lawrence County Road Superintendent or his designee, however, said roadway shall not be required to conform to Lawrence County roadway standards in order to be accepted by the Lawrence County legislative body to be placed in the classification as a Cemetery Road on the county road list;
4. Upon such dedication, inspection and acceptance of such cemetery roadway, the Lawrence County legislative body may add said cemetery roadway to the county road list as Cemetery Road classification, however, any maintenance or work or materials used on such roadway shall be in the sole discretion of the Superintendent of the Lawrence County Highway Department shall be subject to the availability of funds to the County Highway Department and, furthermore, the Lawrence County Highway Department shall not be obligated to regularly maintain such roadway.


This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
