



AN ACT to amend Chapter 311 of the Private Acts of 1901, as amended by Chapter 158 of the Private Acts of 1977 and any other amendatory acts thereto, relative to clerking duties for juvenile and probate matters in Lawrence County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 311 of the Private Acts of 1901, as amended by Chapter 158 of the Private Acts of 1977, is amended by adding the following language to the end of Section 5:

Provided, however, that effective July 1, 2004, the books, records, accounts, papers and documents pertaining to juvenile matters that have been in the custody of the County Clerk shall be transferred to the Circuit Court Clerk who shall have and perform the clerical functions with respect to juvenile court from that date forward; and provided further, that effective July 1, 2004, the books, records, accounts, papers and documents pertaining to probate matters that have been in the custody of the County Clerk shall be transferred to the Clerk and Master of the Chancery Court who shall have and perform the clerical functions with respect to probate court from that date forward.

SECTION 2. All laws or parts of laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Lawrence County. Its approval or non-approval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the county legislative body and certified to the Secretary of State.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective upon approval as provided in Section 3.

WHEREAS, it would be the best interest of Lawrence County, Tennessee for the Legislature to stiffen the penalties for manufacturing, possession, and sale of Methamphetamine and provide mandatory jail time. RESOLUTION TO ADOPT T.C.A. § 54-10-216

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 54-10-216 states:

54-10-216. Closure of public roads by application to county highway department.

Notwithstanding the provisions of this part to the contrary, a county legislative body, by resolution adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote, may adopt the provisions of this section as an alternative procedure for the closing of public roads in the county which are not maintained by any other governmental entity. After adopting the provisions of this section, each application to close a designated public road in the county shall be made in writing to the chief administrative officer. Upon receiving an application to close a public road, the chief administrative officer shall give notice to interested parties as provided in this part. The chief administrative officer shall make a recommendation to the regional planning commission regarding whether or not the public road should be closed. Before making any recommendation with respect to closing a road pursuant to this section, the regional planning commission shall provide notice of such action either by written notice mailed to affected property owners or by notice advertised in a newspaper of general circulation in the county not less than fourteen (14) days before such recommendation is made. After receiving the recommendation of the chief administrative officer, the regional planning commission shall make its recommendation to the county legislative body, and shall attach the recommendation of the chief administrative officer. After receiving the recommendations as provided herein, the county legislative body may, by resolution adopted by a majority of its members, order the closure of the public road.

HISTORY: Acts 1995, ch. 478, § 1.

AND WHEREAS, said statute clarifies and simplifies the process for the closure of public roads.

BE IT THEREFORE NOW RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Legislative body meeting on this 23rd day of March, 2004, that the Lawrence County Legislative body has adopted T.C.A. § 54-10-216 by a 2/3 majority vote.



THIS AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made and entered into this the _____ day of _____, 2004, by and between Lawrence County, Tennessee, a governmental entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of Tennessee (hereinafter "County"), and the City of Lawrenceburg, Tennessee, a governmental entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of Tennessee (hereinafter "City").

**** W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H ****

For and in consideration of the premises and the mutual agreements contained herein, the County and City, each intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

1. Lawrence County Solid Waste is presently in need of an on-sight manager at the Transfer Station in Lawrence County, Tennessee.
2. The Sanitation Supervisor (hereinafter "Supervisor"), who is an employee of the City of Lawrenceburg, and whose office is presently located at the Lawrence County Solid Waste Department.
3. Because of the Supervisor's experience, the parties herein agree that the Supervisor will manage and oversee the County's solid waste employees.
4. The parties further agree that the Supervisor will directly responsible to the Lawrence County Mayor in the execution of all managerial duties.
5. The parties further agree that the Supervisor will remain an employee of the City, however, the County will compensate the City for the Supervisor's assistance in the amount of Seven Thousand and NO/100 (\$7,000.00) Dollars per year, plus provide any benefits available to the Supervisor including retirement on the aforesaid compensation. The City will in turn be

responsible to the Supervisor for the disbursement of the additional compensation. The manner in which the aforesaid compensation will be paid is as follows:

Lawrence County Solid Waste will deposit funds to the City of Lawrenceburg on a monthly basis.

5. The parties further agree that this Agreement is not to be construed as any type of employment contract between the Supervisor and either the City or County.
6. The parties further agree that this Agreement may be terminated by written agreement of the parties or may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days notice in writing by the party wishing to terminate this agreement to the other party.
7. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Tennessee.
