RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A CONTINUING BUDGET AND TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2006 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES FOR THE COUNTY OF LAWRENCE


WHEREAS, it appears that the 2006-2007 fiscal year budget of Lawrence County, Tennessee, will not be approved during the 2006 July term of the Lawrence County Board of Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lawrence County, Tennessee, meeting in duly called special session this 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2006, that the amounts set out in the 2005-2006 Appropriation Resolution are hereby continued until a new 2006-2007 Appropriation Resolution is adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the property tax rate as adopted for the 2005-2006 fiscal year shall remain in effect for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, until a new property tax rate is adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive and County Clerk are hereby authorized to borrow money on tax anticipation notes, not exceeding 60% of the appropriations of each individual fund of the continuing budget, to pay for the expenses herein authorized until the taxes and other revenues for the fiscal year 2006-2007 have been collected. Such notes shall first be approved by the State Director of Local Finance. The notes evidencing the loans authorized under this section shall be issued under the authority of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated. All of said notes shall mature and be paid in full without renewal not later than June 30, 2007.

This resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
