# RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE TO AMEND T.C.A. §5-13-103

WHEREAS, Lawrence County, Tennessee, has enacted the County Procedure Law of 1957 as codified in Chapter 13 of Title 5 of the Tennessee Code; and WHEREAS, County Fiscal

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Legislative Body desires that the Director of Accounts and Budgets shall be appointed by a majority vote of the County Legislative Body; the County Legislative Body establish regulations to which the Director shall adhere to; and the Director of Accounts and Budgets shall not be terminated or discharged without the approval of the County Legislative Body.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in special session this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2006, that the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee is requested to enact the following amendments to T.C.A. §5-13-103, sections (a), (e), and (f)(1):

Section (a) shall be amended as follows: In any county having a population of not less than 39,900 nor more than 40,000, according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census.
