RESOLUTION NO. 2007052216

RESOLUTION TO AMEND CERTAIN RESOLUTIONS REGARDING SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEES, MONETARY PENALTIES AND THE PROGRAM FOR RELIEF FROM SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEES

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, §68-211-835 authorizes counties to impose Solid Waste Disposal Fees for solid waste collection and disposal purposes and to provide for collection of such fees; and

WHEREAS, on August 26, 2003, by Resolution No. 2003082607 (formerly 07082603), the Lawrence County Legislative Body amended previous resolutions regarding Solid Waste Disposal Fees, monetary penalties and the program for relief from Solid Waste Disposal Fees; and

WHEREAS, on August 26, 2003, by Resolution No. 2003082608, the Lawrence County Legislative Body amended certain previous resolutions regarding the collection of Solid Waste Disposal Fees; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2005, by Resolution No. 200592712, the Lawrence County Legislative Body amended the Solid Waste Disposal Fee and amended the schedule of Solid Waste Disposal rates; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence County has in excess of five years experience in the implementation and collection of Solid Waste Disposal Fees and the rates for disposal of solid waste and the Lawrence County Legislative Body finds that the fees set forth herein bare a reasonable relationship to the cost of providing solid waste disposal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in regular session this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May, 2007, that the following fees, schedules and provisions are hereby adopted:

**Section 1. Imposition of Solid Waste Disposal Fee.** Except as may hereinafter be provided, there is hereby imposed an annual Solid Waste Disposal Fee upon each household and governmental entity in Lawrence County and upon each business, corporation, company or business entity located in Lawrence County for the purpose of collecting and disposing the solid waste generated in Lawrence County, such fee to be in the amounts set forth herein. Uninhabitable residences, vacant buildings, barns, sheds, grain bins, chicken houses, hobby shops, storage buildings, pump houses, **and** part-time residences used less than 30 days per year and in which the owner lives outside of Lawrence County shall be exempt from the Solid Waste Disposal Fee upon application for exemption made to Solid Waste Services as hereinafter set forth.

**Section 2. Solid Waste Disposal Fee Schedule.** The schedule of Solid Waste Disposal Fees and Solid Waste Disposal Rates is attached hereto and incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**Section 3. Collection and Use of Solid Waste Disposal Fees.**

3.1 The annual and/or monthly fees set out in this Resolution shall be collected by Solid Waste Services under the direction of the Lawrence County legislative body and/or the Solid Waste Committee of the Lawrence County legislative body.

3.2 All such revenues collected shall be deposited in the county's Solid Waste Management Fund, which shall be a special revenue fund segregated from the general fund, and shall be used only for solid waste operations, including but not limited to, collection, disposal purposes, and recycling.

**Section 4. Delinquent Solid Waste Disposal Fees.**

4.1 Any payment which is not made within 30 days of the due date on the payment schedule set forth herein is delinquent. Fees which are 90 days delinquent will be referred to the Solid Waste Committee of the Lawrence County legislative body for resolution.

4.2 Solid Waste Services and/or the Solid Waste Committee of the Lawrence County legislative body shall cause to be delivered to all delinquent customers of Solid Waste Services a notice of the delinquency including the amount of past due Solid Waste Disposal Fees and penalties with a request to the customer to show cause why the



delinquent Solid Waste Disposal Fee is not rightfully due and payable. If the customer fails to show cause why the delinquent Solid Waste Disposal Fee including penalty is not rightfully due and owing to Solid Waste Services, then collection of said fees shall be pursued by Solid Waste Services and/or the Solid Waste Committee of the Lawrence County legislative body.

4.3 The Solid Waste Committee of the Lawrence County legislative body is authorized to make agreements with such customers on a case-by-case basis for a payment schedule or to turn over such delinquent accounts to a collection agency, reporting delinquencies to a credit bureau, or take other measures including filing suits against such customers to recover said delinquent Solid Waste Disposal Fees.

Section 5. **Monetary Penalty, Costs of Collection and Attorney's Fees.** In the event the county commences a suit for collection of a delinquent Solid Waste Disposal Fee, the person(s) or entity against whom such suit is commenced shall also be liable for all cost of collection, including all reasonable attorney's fee.

Section 6. **Hardship.** Commencing with the October 15, 2003, annual fee, relief from Solid Waste Disposal Fees for residential customers shall be reviewed and approved by the Solid Waste Committee or its designee.

6.1 Residential customers who meet the statutory standards for property tax relief as codified in T.C.A. §67-5-701 through §67-5-704, regardless of whether the customer is a property owner, and who apply for exemption or reduction of the Solid Waste Disposal Fee, shall be charged a Solid Waste Disposal Fee of one-half (1/2) of the Solid Waste Disposal Fee set forth in Section 2 hereof.

6.2 Other: Residential customers may make application to the Solid Waste Committee if there are other extenuating circumstances justifying relief from the Solid Waste Disposal Fee, which matters shall be taken up on a case-by-case basis by the Solid Waste Committee of the Lawrence County legislative body.


6.3 Form for Application: All customers who desire to make application for Solid Waste Disposal Fee exemptions or reductions shall be required to complete the form which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, which forms will be reviewed by the Solid Waste Committee of the Lawrence County legislative body.

Section 7. **Repeal of Prior Resolutions.** All provisions contained in Resolution Nos. 2003082607, 2003082608 and 200592712 inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed, prospectively.


Section 8. **Captions.** The captions used in this Resolution are intended for convenience only and should not be taken into consideration in any construction or interpretation of this Resolution or any of its provisions.

This resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
