WHEREAS, Methamphetamine abuse is a fast growing societal problem that is only getting worse in Lawrence County and around our nation. Further, the meth labs that are created pose an extreme danger to the general public as well as the officers that work to dismantle them.

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Sheriff's Department has put a concentrated effort into suppressing all meth abuse in Lawrence County. In fact, our Drug Taskforce team was named the number one team in the state in 2009 for their anti-meth efforts.

WHEREAS, during the current budget negotiations within the federal government, funding for meth lab cleanup was cut. If these proposed cuts are to become permanent, local governments such as ours would have to eat the cost of each meth lab which average about \$3,000. And with our drug agents destroying more and more labs each month in Lawrence County, the costs will add up quick.

WHEREAS, many local governments just will not be able to absorb the costs which will force local agencies to have to make the tough decision of reducing their anti-meth efforts or spending scarce tax payer money to fund the cleanup.

WHEREAS, the County Legislative Body agrees that spending needs to be reduced in our nation's capital, we do not feel it needs to be done so on the backs of crucial local law enforcement efforts such as this.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in regular sessions this 22nd day of March, 2011, that Lawrence County Government urges Congressman Scott DesJarlais and Senators Lamar Alexander and Bob Corker to support the restoration of funding to the federal budget for meth lab cleanup.

RESOLUTION TO RESCIND AMENDED RESOLUTION NO. 201102401 AWARDING CONTRACT FOR WASTE SUPPLY SERVICES AND DISPOSAL, AND OPERATION OF THE SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION TO WASTE CONNECTIONS OF MISSISSIPPI, INC.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2011022401, the Lawrence County Legislative Body awarded the agreement for Waste Supply Services and Disposal, Operation of a Solid Waste Transfer Station to Waste Connections of Mississippi, Inc. subject to further negotiations of additional terms and/or services more favorable to Lawrence County; and,

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2011, Waste Services of Decatur, LLC filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Writ of Supersedeas in the Chancery Court of Lawrence County titled <u>"Waste Services of Decatur, LLC, Petitioner v. County of Lawrence, County Commission of the County of Lawrence, and Waste Connections of Mississippi, Inc., Respondents"</u>, No. 15259-11, and the Chancery Court having issued a Writ of Supersedeas which has effectively ordered Lawrence County to maintain the status quo with its current provider, Waste Services of Decatur, LLC; and,

WHEREAS, while the Lawrence County legislative body has acted in good faith in its previous actions regarding the contractual services for the disposal of solid waste generated in Lawrence County, it desires to bring about the termination of the herein referenced litigation by rescinding its action February 24, 2011, by declaring that all proposals submitted for solid waste services, loading, transportation and disposal of solid waste be rejected and for Lawrence County to immediately seek new proposals from any provider desiring to make a proposal; and,

WHEREAS, such recision of Amended Resolution No. 2011022401 and the notice of the rejection of all proposals and the new request for proposals shall be contingent upon (1) The Chancery Court allowing Lawrence County to issue a notice rejecting all proposals, and (2) That the current Chancery Court in effect in Case No. 15259-11 remain in effect until a new agreement is entered into between Lawrence County and a provider for the disposal of solid waster generated in Lawrence County and the operation of a solid waste transfer station.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in regular session this 22nd day of March, 2011, that:

- (1) Amended Resolution No. 2011022401 is hereby rescinded and is of no further force or effect;
- (2) The purchasing agent for Lawrence County is hereby directed to send all vendors submitting proposals in response to Lawrence County request for proposals for solid waste services, loading, transportation and disposal of solid waste issued on or about December 13, 2010, are rejected;
- (3) That the purchasing agent as soon as possible issue a new Request for Proposals for Solid Waste Services for the Loading, Transportation and Disposal of Solid Waste for Lawrence County and Operation of the Lawrence County Transfer Station, and such request for proposals be issued in a manner for competitive type bids wherein the lowest bidder is awarded the contract;

(4) This resolution and the actions directed to the Purchasing Agent are contingent upon the following: The Chancery Court of Lawrence County entering an order (a) allowing the Purchasing Agent for Lawrence County to reject all proposals previously submitted for the disposal of solid waste and, (b) the order requiring Waste Services of Decatur, LLC to continue to provide all services that it is currently providing to Lawrence County at the rate of \$33.88 per ton with no fuel surcharge and that all terms and conditions of the contract between Lawrence County and Waste Services of Decatur, LLC dated March 5, 2006, shall remain in effect until a new agreement for the disposal of solid waste and operation of the Lawrence County Transfer Station becomes effective.

This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it. Withdrawn this 22nd day of March, 2011.
