GOVERNMENT SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Commission and Lawrence County Government want to encourage local youth to become more involved in making a positive difference in Lawrence County. Our county faces many challenging issues and the Commission believes that it is vital to have the next generation of Lawrence Countians involved in the decision making process.

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Commission has the opinion that there is no higher calling than to serve others. With that opinion, the County Commission shall establish an academic scholarship that will be awarded yearly to a graduating high school student who meets the following criteria:

- 4) Must complete 100 hours annually of community service, under the guidance of the County Commission.


