This letter acknowledges receipt of a request for approval to issue an amount not-to-exceed \$750,000 General Fund Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes, Series 2011, (the "TRANs"). The notes will be issued as an interfund loan from the General Purpose School Fund. Counties in Tennessee are authorized to issue TRANs pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated to provide monies for operating expenses until sufficient revenues are received. The amount of TRANs which may be issued must not exceed 60% of the annual appropriation for the fund involved, and sufficient future revenues must be anticipated allowing payment of the TRANs by the end of the fiscal year of issuance. Issuing the TRANs reduces the amount that the County may borrow in the future. We have determined this request meets the statutory requirements.

The notes will be issued as an interfund loan from the General Debt Service Fund. Counties in Tennessee are authorized to issue TRANs pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Cade Annotated to provide monies for operating expenses until sufficient revenues are received. The amount of TRANs which may be issued must not exceed 60% of the annual appropriation for the fund involved, and sufficient future revenues must be anticipated allowing payment of the TRANs by the end of the fiscal year of issuance. Issuing the TRANs reduces the amount that the County may borrow in the future. We have determined this request meets the statutory requirements.

Provide a copy of this letter to all the members of the County Commission after receipt, present it for discussion at the next meeting of the Commission after receipt, and include it in the minutes of that meeting.

The financial information received with the request for approval of TRANs represents the County's assertions of its financial condition that may or may not reflect the current or future financial condition of the County.

Nothing in this chapter shall prohibit or be construed as prohibiting the county road commission, the state, or any municipality or its agents, from doing work gratuitously for cemeteries, churches, schools, and any other charitable nonprofit organization, or from making sales of agricultural lime to farmers for use in connection with their own farming activities.

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Attorney General has opined that the Tennessee County Uniform Highway Law and particularly, T.C.A. § 54-7-202, prohibits a county road department from doing work for any private use and that said statute prevails over T.C.A. § 12-8-103.

WHEREAS, there are public cemeteries in Lawrence County that are unable to afford regular maintenance, however, are still being used for burials and it is in the best interest for the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Lawrence County that the Lawrence County Highway Department have the ability to perform road work on the roadways in such cemeteries.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in regular session this 22nd day of November, 2011, that the Tennessee General Assembly is requested and encouraged to enact legislation to allow county highway departments to perform roadwork for public cemeteries.

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A PLAN OF REAPPORTIONMENT DISTRICTING FOR THE LAWRENCE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY, THE LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE LAWRENCE COUNTY CONSTABLE DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 5-1-111 requires that, at least every ten (10) years, County Legislative Bodies shall change the boundaries of county legislative districts so that members represent substantially equal populations; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Legislative Body has reviewed the County Legislative districts population utilizing the 2010 United States Census; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Legislative Body has prepared a plan of apportionment consistent with the provisions of T.C.A. § 5-1-111 and which provides for a county legislative body composed of 18 members and which creates 18 commissioner districts as described herein and as depicted on the Official Reapportionment Plan Map for Lawrence County and which creates Board of Education member districts and three constable districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in regular session this 22nd day of November, 2011, that:

Section 1.

There is hereby adopted a plan of reapportionment for Lawrence County as described herein, and which is served by one (1) Commissioner in each of the eighteen (18) districts for a total County Legislative Body of eighteen (18) members. The districts for members of the County Legislative Body are depicted on the official Reapportionment Map which is attached as Exhibit A to this Resolution and is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2.

- a. All members of the Lawrence County Legislative Body shall reside within and be qualified voters in the district which they represent.
- b. The districts described in Section 1 correspond to the 2010 U.S. Census blocks as detailed in Appendix 1 to this Resolution.

Section 3.

If any vacancies occur during the term of the present members of the Lawrence County Legislative Body or the Lawrence County Board of Education or a Lawrence County Constable, the vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the term using the reapportionment plan in effect prior to the adoption of this plan. The present members shall serve the remainder of the term for which they were elected.

Section 4.

All members of the Lawrence County Legislative Body and the Lawrence County Board of Education shall be elected at large within the commissioner district wherein the candidate seeks election.

Section 5.

This plan also provides for the following reapportionment of the Lawrence County School Board. There will be nine (9) districts for members of the Lawrence County Board of Education, each comprised of two County Commissioner Districts.

District 1	County Commission Districts 6 and 13
District 2	County Commission Districts 1 and 2
District 3	County Commission Districts 3 and 4
District 4	County Commission Districts 5 and 7
District 5	County Commission Districts 11 and 12
District 6	County Commission Districts 14 and 15
District 7	County Commission Districts 9 and 10
District 8	County Commission Districts 16 and 17
District 9	County Commission Districts 8 and 18

Section 6.

The Lawrence County Constables have also been reapportioned to coincide with the new County Commission Districts. There are three (3) Constables who will now represent the following districts.

Middle Constable County Commission Districts 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 County Commission Districts 7, 8, 15, 16, 17 and 18 County Commission Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6

Section 7.

This plan shall take effect upon passage, the public welfare requiring it, but shall be implemented with the August, 2012, general election for members of the Lawrence County Board of Education and the August, 2014, general election for members of the Lawrence County Legislative Body and Constables.

RESOLUTION REQUIRING ALL APPOINTMENTS TO COUNTY BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS TO FIRST HAVE A RECOMMENDATION FROM THE ETHICS AND RULES COMMITTEES BEFORE BEING CONSIDERED BY THE FULL COUNTY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, there are many important appointments made throughout any given year by the County Executive and County Commission to various boards, committees and commissions in Lawrence County. These unelected positions play a vital role in function of our government as the decisions they make can have a direct affect on the people of Lawrence County. Therefore, it is important that well qualified and responsible people are appointed to these positions.

WHEREAS, the current process only requires that names be submitted and put on the agenda to be voted on by the full county commission. This process often leaves questions in regards to the nominee in question, thus making it difficult for commissioners to cast an informed vote either way on the nominee.

WHEREAS, in an effort to increase professionalism, efficiency and to make sure well qualified and responsible people are serving in these appointed positions within Lawrence County Government, the process for appointment will now be the following:

- 1) Names shall be submitted for appointment by the County Executive/County Commission.
- 2) Once a name(s) is submitted for a specified appointment, a joint meeting of the Ethics Committee and Rules Committee will then be scheduled.
- 3) An Ethics and Rules Committee meeting will then be held with the nominees being present at the meeting. Qualifications and other background information shall be reviewed at this time by the committees.
- 4) After the consideration of each nominee, the two committees will then hold a joint vote to recommend or reject each nominee. Voting shall be for one nominee at a time. No vote shall be taken to recommend or reject multiple nominees at once.
- 5) If the nominee is recommended by the committees, the recommendation will then be voted upon by the full commission at the next regular session/special session meeting.

(Please note: County Commission Committee Appointments are not affected by these guidelines.)

WHEREAS, this process will streamline the nomination process and will allow for the proper vetting of all appointed positions within Lawrence County Government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in regular session this 22nd day of November, 2011, that the Lawrence County Legislative Body recommends that all appointments to county boards, committees and

commissions first have a recommendation from the Ethics and Rules Committees before being considered by the full Lawrence County Legislative Body.

RESOLUTION TO AMEND LAWRENCE COUNTY BEER ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THAT APPLICANTS FOR BEER PERMITS WILL BE SUBJECT TO A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK TO BE PAID FOR BY COUNTY FUNDS AND REQUIRING APPLICANTS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES TO SUBMIT STATEMENTS FROM TENNESSEE LICENSED SURVEYORS AND PROVIDING FOR THE MEASUREMENT OF DISTANCES FROM THE PROPOSED LOCATION TO A CHURCH, SCHOOL OR OTHER PLACE OF PUBLIC GATHERING

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted July 12, 1943, Lawrence County Quarterly Court enacted a resolution for the purpose of, among other things, to provide for and regulate actions on the granting of permits for the sale of, storage, manufacture, or distribution of beer with an alcoholic content of not more than 5% by weight or any other beverage of like alcoholic content outside the limits of any incorporated municipality and to establish a beverage permit committee and to prescribe the duties and authorize the exercise of powers and direction by Lawrence County's Beverage Permit Committee; and

WHEREAS, by said prior resolution of the Lawrence County Quarterly Court, Lawrence County, among other things, prohibited that no beer permit could be issued authorizing the sale of, storage, manufacture, or distribution of beer within 2,000 feet of any school, church or other place of public gathering; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted October 10, 1977, the Lawrence County Legislative Body adopted the provisions of T.C.A. § 57-5-105(i) forbidding the sale of beer within 300 feet of a residential dwelling, measured from building to building; provided that the owner of the residential building appears in person before the County Beer Board and objects to the issuance of such permit or license; and

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 57-5-105(b)(4) provides "no person employed by the applicant in such distribution or sale has been convicted of any violation of the laws against possession, sale, manufacture, or transportation of beer or other alcoholic beverages or the manufacture, delivery, sale or possession with intent to manufacture, deliver or sell any controlled substance that is listed in Schedule I though V in Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 4, or any crime involving moral turpitude within the past ten (10) years;" and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Legislative Body deems it advisable that a criminal background check be conducted on any applicant, the cost of such background check to be borne by Lawrence County; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Legislative Body further desires to establish clear rules for the measurement of the distance between the applicant's place of business and the closest school, church or other place of public gathering; and

WHEREAS, due to the passage of liquor by the drink in the City of Lawrenceburg, and the provisions of T.C.A. § 57-5-301(b)(5)(A) requires that the hours for the sale of beer in that

part of the county outside of incorporated municipalities should be the same as the hours authorized by the rules and regulations promulgated by the Alcoholic Beverage Commission established for selling liquor by the drink.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in regular session this 22nd day of November, 2011, that the Resolution adopted by the Lawrence County Quarterly Court on July 12, 1943, and any subsequent resolutions are hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. No permit authorizing the sale of beer will be issued when such business would cause congestion of traffic or interference with schools, churches or other places of public gathering or otherwise interfere with public health, safety and morals. In no event will a permit be issued authorizing the manufacture or storage of beer or sale of beer within 2,000 feet of any school, church or other place of public gathering. The distance shall be measured in a straight line from the closest point on the building from which beer will be manufactured, stored or sold to the closest point of the school, church or other place of public gathering.

Section 2. That the provisions of T.C.A. §57-1-105(i) providing the sale of beer is forbidden within 300 feet of a residential dwelling, measuring from building to building; provided, that the owner of the residential dwelling appears in person before the County Beer Board and objects to the issuance of such permit or license is hereby expressly ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. Any applicants for a permit for the sale of, storage, manufacture or distribution of beer shall be subject to a criminal background check with any cost thereof to be borne by Lawrence County. The County Clerk shall be responsible for obtaining the criminal background check.

Section 4. Measuring Distance.

- (a) The distance from the building from which beer will be manufactured, stored or sold shall be measured in a straight line from the closest point of the building from which beer will be manufactured, stored or sold to the closest point of the school, church or other place of public gathering.
- (b) If there is a place of public gathering which does not have a building or structure located thereon, the distance shall be measured in a straight line from the closest point on the building from which beer will be manufactured, stored or sold to the closest property boundary line of the property on which the place of public gathering is located.
- (c) If it appears there may be some question as to whether an exact measurement is needed, the Beer Board/Beverage Permit Committee, at its discretion may require the applicant to provide an affidavit and plat from a Tennessee licensed surveyor of the distance, measured in a straight line, between the closest point on the building from which beer will be manufactured, stored or sold to the closest point of the school, church or other place of public gathering or in the case of a place of public gathering that does not have a building or structure located thereon, to the closest property boundary line; which survey shall be at the applicant's expense.

Section 5. <u>Hours of Operation</u>. No alcoholic beverage within the scope of this resolution shall be sold between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on Monday through Saturday or between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. on Sunday.

Section 6. Any prior resolution adopted by the Lawrence County Legislative Body in conflict with this resolution is hereby amended to conform to this resolution.

Section 7. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such language or portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity or the remaining portions thereof, unless so noted by the court.
